

Emboss the ribbon wrap on the Groovi Plate. Do any other embossing or colouring you wish and then picot cut or cut out with scissors or a craft knife around the outer edges. With scissors, carefully cut the indicated dotted line on the tabs. It's best not to picot cut this; use scissors or a craft knife and be careful only to cut where the dotted line indicates. Wrap your ribbon around the narrow side of your envelope and interlink the tabs.

The tabs shown above should be interlinked behind the wrap. However, if you take a look at the heart and rose tabs, these are decorative and if you interlink them to the outside of the wrap they make a nice feature. The tabs are interchangeable. You can also shorten or lengthen your wraps at the cut line with some careful measuring. If you make a mistake, just stick the tabs together instead of interlinking them. Don't just use them on envelopes, they can be used on your cards and would also look lovely wrapped around a small gift box.
