

WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND RELEASE OF ALL CLAIMS

Please read. Consent to document is on the Registration Form.

This waiver and release is signed during the registration process at the top of our registration form.

As parent and/or guardian of ______, I am authorized to execute this waiver of liability as to the Art Academy at Art-Kitect on behalf of my minor child and myself. As a condition of participating in a Art Academy at Art-Kitect, Inc ("Art-Kitect Inc.") program, I understand that I must agree to waive any legal liability claims against Art-Kitect Inc.. I understand that Art-Kitect Inc. will try to ensure that its programs are safe and enjoyable for its participants, but I also understand that accidents may happen. I fully waive and release Art-Kitect Inc. and all of its members, employees, and agents from any and all claims and causes of action existing now or in the future as a result of my child's participation in activities with Art-Kitect Inc.. I agree not to sue Art-Kitect Inc. and its members, employees and agents as a result of any claim, injury or event that may occur as a result f participation in activities with Art-Kitect Inc.. I agree to indemnify Art-Kitect Inc. and its members, employees, and agents against all claims, damages, and attorney's fees relating to my child's participation in Art-Kitect Inc. activities.

EMERGENCIES

If your child requires any medicine on site (including an EpiPen or Benadryl) you must provide said product to Art-Kitect Inc.. I understand that participation in camp activities involve some inherent risks and danger of accidents resulting in physical injury. Knowing these risks, I hereby assume these risks on behalf of my minor child. In addition, I hereby authorize the staff of The Art Academy at Art-Kitect to use their best judgment in any emergency situation and release Art-Kitect Inc. from liability resulting from injury sustained, including death, as a result of participation in the camp.

MEDIA RELEASE

I also acknowledge that Art-Kitect Inc. may periodically photograph or video its participants and their artwork and I grant my full permission for Art-Kitect Inc. to photograph, video, record, or reproduce images of my child and their artwork. I consent to Art-Kitect Inc. 's use of these recordings and agree to relinquish any claims to royalties or damages.

ALLERGIES

I acknowledge and understand that Art-Kitect Inc. has a NO nut product requirement for all Participants and their families. This means that I promise not to provide my child with any food items containing nuts, nut by-products, or made in contact with nuts for consumption at Art-Kitect Inc. or on any Art-Kitect Inc. function. I understand that many children have peanut and other nut



allergies and that sending my child with nut-containing products may cause allergic reactions in other participants. If my child has a nut allergy, I understand that it is impossible to eliminate all nut contact. I hereby waive any and all claims against Art-Kitect Inc. for any exposure, intentional and/or negligent, my child may encounter to nut, nut by-product, or product made in contact with nuts.

OFFSITE TRIPS, SCHOOL PICK UP AND OUTINGS RELEASE

I understand and give permission to Art-Kitect Staff to pick up my child from their attending school and bring them to Art-Kitect's Studio (401 Danforth Ave. Upper)) for my child's registered art class. I understand that my child will be walking with a designated staff member from my child's school (401 Danforth Ave. Upper)). to I understand that Art-Kitect Inc. and Staff Members may take my child offsite to other facilities and Toronto City Park grounds. The release, covenant not to sue, and assumption of risk in this document shall be as broad and inclusive as is permitted under applicable law. REFUND/ CANCELLATIONS FOR ART CLASSES

Refunds of our classes are gladly given on "Art Class" purchases up to the first day of class, <u>less a \$ 50.00 administration fee per student and less the amount of any</u> <u>class days attended or missed in their semester</u>.

Unfortunately, we cannot offer refunds for sick days or inclement weather at this time. If in the event our studio needs to be shut down due to any reason or our art instructors need to cancel a class, we will hold a makeup class at a later date free of charge.

MISSED ART CLASSES

There are no make-up classes or refunds on missed classes or unused classes when purchasing anything at Art-Kitect <u>AT A SALE OR DISCOUNTED PRICE. NO</u>



SALE OR DISCOUNTED CLASSES CAN BE ROLLED FORWARD into the next semester. No exceptions.

There are no make-up classes/credits for missed classes due to illness, work commitments or vacations when purchasing any amount of classes or packages with the exception of the "10-Class Pack" at our standard pricing. Parents are encouraged to purchase a "Full Semester Package" of classes over the course of the year. <u>up to 1 class is missed</u>, can be rolled forward/ made-up with the next purchase of classes with a deduction of this 1 class. That is to say, you will be billed for 9 classes instead of 10. <u>Classes cannot be made-up in the next scholastic year.</u> <u>There are no other exceptions</u>. <u>All art classes stop in June for the year and a new year starts September of the same year.</u>

It is extremely important your child attends our classes in order. Our art classes are cumulative at every level and we do our best to ensure that the students that are in class are getting the best educational experience possible. If a class is missed for any reason, the teacher will not be re-teaching that specific class. You may schedule a private lesson with Elissa if you wish to continue a specific project that you missed.

Trial Classes

Students are eligible for 1 trial class at a rate of \$ 15.00 + HST per participant. The trial rate will not be continued after 1 class. If you wish to purchase individual classes, you may do so at the standard rate offered for your class.

REFUND/ CANCELLATIONS FOR CAMP

Registration payment for Art Camp is refundable up to 2 weeks prior to your first day of Art Camp less a \$ 100.00 + HST administration fee/ week/ camper. After the 2-week grace period, Art-Kitect Inc. will not issue refunds on your payment. Unfortunately, we cannot offer refunds for sick days at this time. In the event our studio needs to be shut down due to any reason around Covid you will receive a full refund of your deposit and payment for camp.

CAMP LOCATION, PICKUP + DROP OFF

Art-Kitect's Art Camp is located at 401 Danforth Ave (Upper Floor), Toronto, ON. We understand that Danforth Avenue is a busy street. For your convenience, Art-Kitect is located directly across the street from Chester Subway Station (Bloor Line) and Arundale Green P lot 087. You may also park on Danforth Ave. or around the corner.

Our day camp starts at 9:00 AM and ends at 4:00 PM, every day, Monday through Friday. Camper morning drop off is at 8:45 AM - 9:00 AM, and evening pickup is at 4:00 PM - 4:20 PM. (When available, extended care is until 6:00 PM.)

CAMPER DRESS CODE

We ask that campers wear weather appropriate clothing and comfortable shoes. Paint has a tendency to stain clothing, so please remember this when sending your child to camp. Please refrain from sending your child in nice clothing and flip flops, as campers do get to experience outdoor physical activity daily. Our 2021 motto: **Dress for Mess... Smocks are Provided! Wear your mask if sick or coughing!**

WAIVER

A waiver MUST be completed upon registration or brought in on your child's first day of camp. Please click the "Waiver and Release Form" button in our "Art Camp" section on our main webpage. All forms for camp are mandatory.

FOOD + DRINK POLICY

We strive to maintain a NUT-FREE studio, and ask that parents pack a NUT-FREE snack & lunch for their child. Campers must bring a water bottle everyday. Please ensure that his/her name is marked/tagged on the bottle.

SICK DAYS

If your child is feeling ill or showing any signs of illness (or Covid-19 symptoms) please keep your child home. Please see our Refund/Cancellation Policy above.



MAINTAINING A RESPECTFUL ENVIRONMENT

Respectful, positive, encouraging and fun environments are important to us at the Academy. Our expectation is that all of our students and parents will show respect to each other and to our instructors. There is a zero-tolerance policy for in person or cyber bullying. STUDIO CLOSURES
