OBJECTIVE

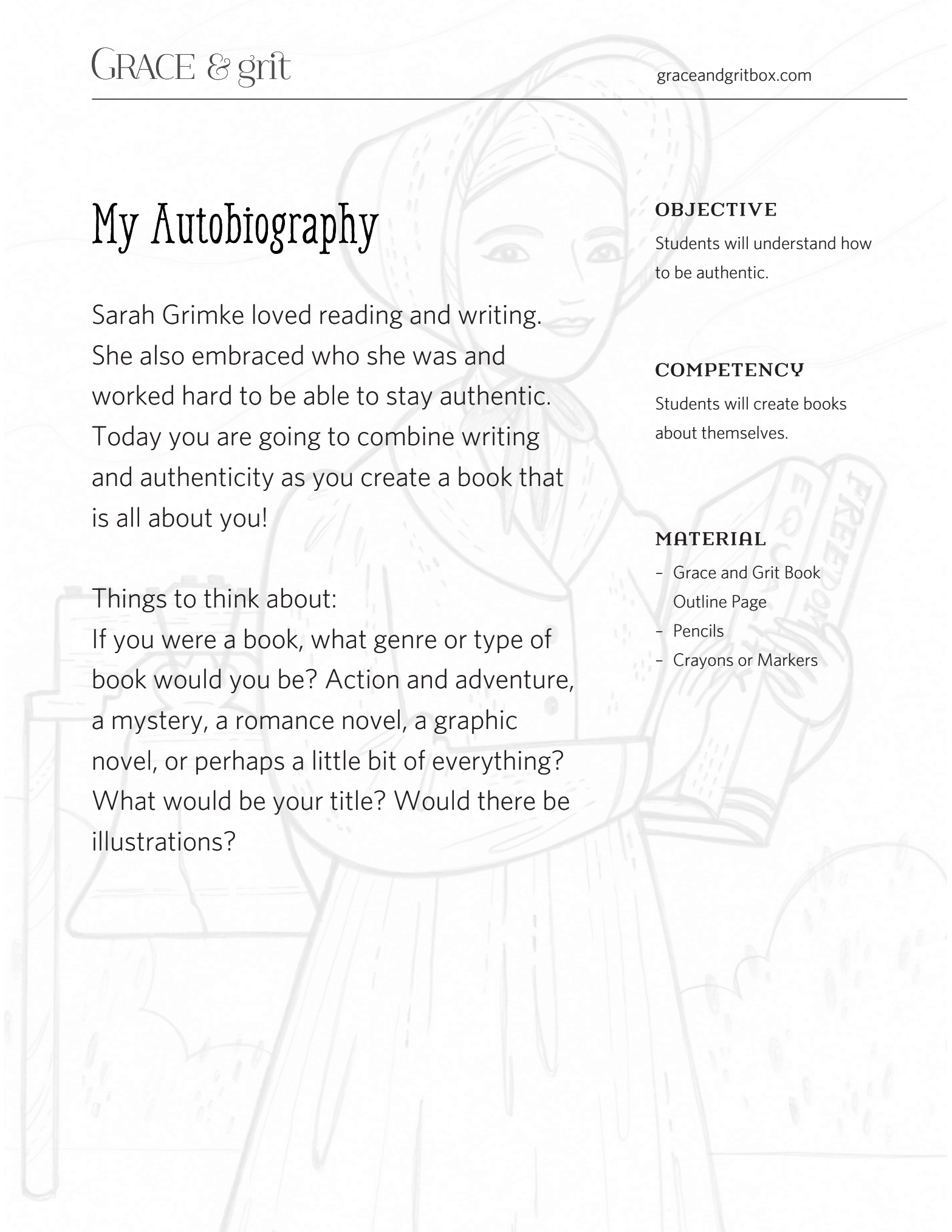
Students will understand how to be authentic.

How to use the book outline.

Book cover: This page will be the front and back cover of your book. Design it however you want. Be sure to write your title on it.

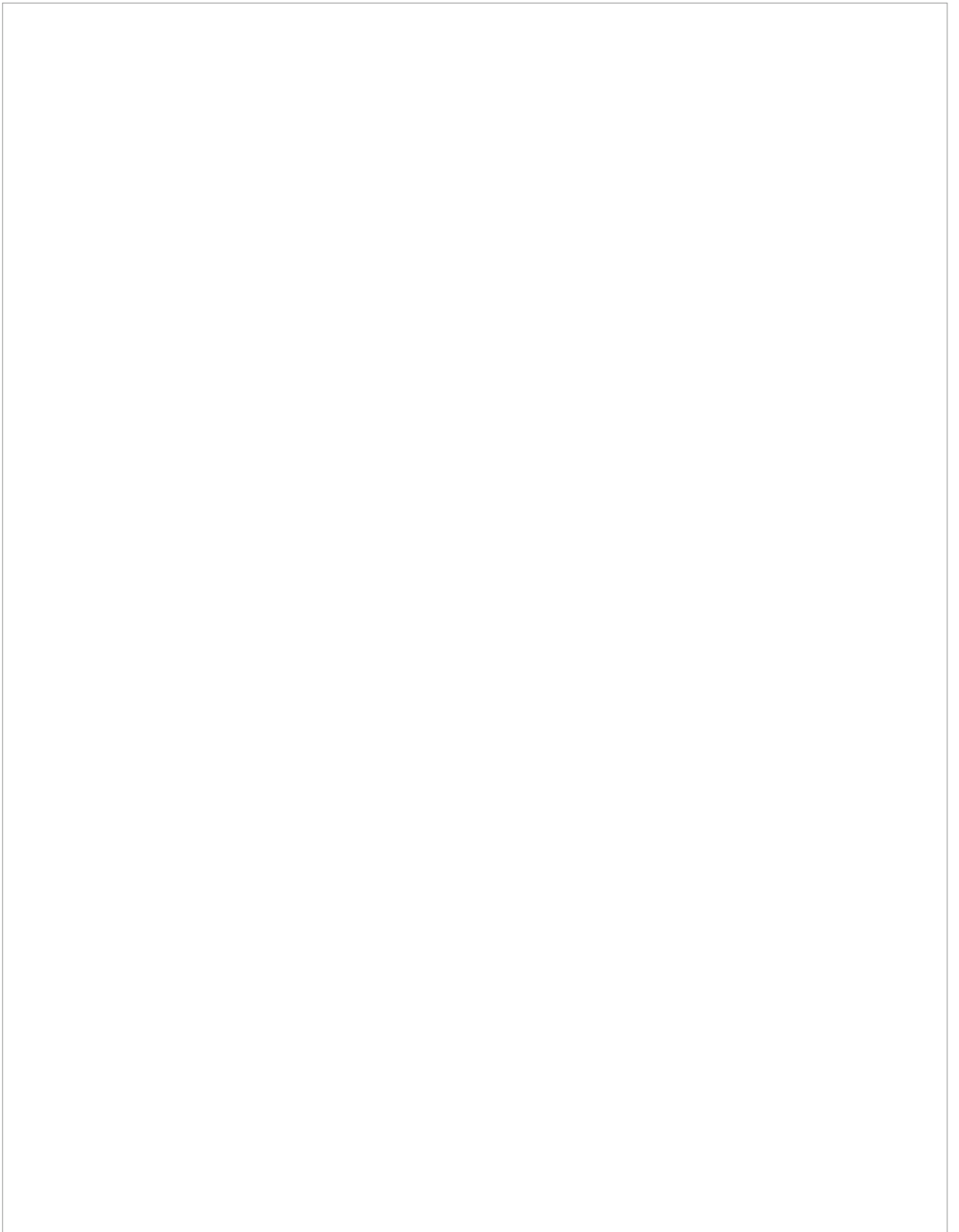
Lined pages: Use as many pages as you want and write about yourself. You can write about your whole life or write about a specific moment in your life that represents your most authentic self.

Pages with rectangles: If you like to draw, use these pages for your illustrations. Draw moments of your life to include in the book.

Take your time and remember to be authentic!
