PERMA TRANS™ Wood Transfer

Inkjet & Laser Transfer
Paper for Wooden Substrates



ITEMS YOU WILL NEED

Wood block, plaques, letters or other wooden substrate



Scissors



Wood Transfer paper



Cricut or Hand Iron (DO NOT use steam)



Parchment or Micro Fiber Cloth

STEP ONE - PRINTING YOUR IMAGE



Bring your paper to room temperature before printing.



Load the transfer sheets into your printer so that the image is printed on the non-glossy (unlined) side.



Using your computer, select or design the images to be transferred. **DO NOT MIRROR OR FLIP THE IMAGE BEFORE PRINTING.**



Print image/design on paper using the following recommended print settings dependent on the brand of your printer:

STEP TWO - TRANSFERRING THE IMAGE



Use scissors to cut around the transfer artwork to remove access.



 Peel liner from back of transfer upward at a 90° angle.
 Place your printed image/design on top of the wood with the design/image facing up.

For a Crisp Image result where the wood does not show through as much, use a micro fiber cloth to place over the top of the transfer work.



For a Rustic look resulting in a slightly more transparent transfer where the wood will show through, use parchment paper over the top of the transfer work and iron until white background/non-image area turns transparent, paying close attention to not overheat.



PARCHMENT NOTE: If using a Laser printer, please check that you do not have any residue on parchment from previous transfer. If you do, please use a clean/ new piece from kit.

Option 1) CRICUT PRESS



- 1. Preheat your Cricut to 350°
- 2. Using FIRM, EVEN PRESSURE, press the Cricut firmly over each portion of the transfer for:



- * 45-90 seconds for 8.5x11 sizes and
- * 90-180 seconds for 11x17

 * Be sure to cover all corners and edges.
- 3. After it is completely transparent, COLD PEEL ONLY- Let transfer cool down completely prior to peeling parchment paper/ microfiber cloth.

Option 2) HAND IRON



 Preheat your iron to the hottest setting (typically a "Linen" setting)



- Using FIRM, EVEN PRESSURE, hold iron on each area of the sheet while moving to a new position. Continue this process for:
 - * 5-10 minutes for 8.5x11 sizes and
 - * 10-15 minutes for 11x17 sizes
 - * Be sure to cover all corners and edges.
- After it is completely transparent, COLD PEEL ONLY- Let transfer cool down completely prior to peeling parchment paper/ microfiber cloth.

NOTES

- When transferring several images, be sure to cover all applications to ensure none of the transfers are damaged from direct exposure to heat.
- The final transfer is supposed to look rustic in nature.
- · For best results, use craft wood that is untreated or stained.
- · Lift up a corner of the parchment to make sure it is transferred completely, if it isn't replace parchment and continue ironing.
- · Overheating/burning the transfer may cause bubbles/cracking appear.
