




*All models follow the same assembly procedure varying only in the number of middle ladders your rack will require.



- 1. Find an open, flat area in which to work. Carefully remove all components from the box and remove banding with a utility knife. Check the parts list to verify package contents.
- 2. Arrange the left and right end ladders on the floor so that the bottle support pieces face one another. Align the large gaps on each end ladder. The end with the larger gap is the top of your rack. Attach a standard column connector to the top and bottom of your rack using the screws provided. Make sure the connectors are flush with the top and bottom of your rack. (figure 1)







***NOTE:** If you purchased a 12 bottle high display top, your unit will come with 1 extra standard connector. Attach the connector to the back of the rack with a cordless drill or screwdriver.




IMPORTANT!

Measurements are from the bottom of the rack to the top of the connector

4. Flip rack over. Attach the remaining connectors to the top and bottom of the rack using the provided screws. (figure 3)

Cover the screw holes on the front connectors using the provided adhesive screw covers.





5. Insert a metal U-bar into the two pre-drilled holes of each display tray by pushing down on the U-bar until it reaches the bottom of the holes. (figure 4)

Stand your rack upright. To secure your display trays to your rack, apply a bead of wood glue to each of the two grooves on the back of the tray. (figure 5)



That's it! Enjoy this beautiful rack with your favorite beverage. Pair with other rack styles for an ultimate cellar storage look.
