

Articulated Shank Family





Articulated streamers, simplified.

- The original Articulated Shank created by Martin Bawden.
- A general purpose shank used for tying many styles of articulated flies, such as single-hook and double-hook articulated streamers, poppers, and sliders.
- Stainless steel.
- 20 mm (0.79 in), 35 mm (1.38 in), 55 mm (2.17 in).



Tie large, articulated streamers to catch river, lake, and sea monsters.

- Beefed-up shank for big predator streamers.
- Co-developed with Blane Chocklett.
- Optimized for strength with heavy-gauge, stainless steel wire, and has extended length with oversized loops for bigger hooks.
- 28 mm (1.1 in), 40 mm (1.57 in), 80 mm (3.15 in).



Tie animated Game Changer-style baitfish patterns with ultra-lifelike action.

- Shank system for creating multi-jointed, highly articulated streamers.
- Co-developed with Blane Chocklett.
- Stainless steel.
- 10 mm (0.39 in), 15 mm (0.59 in), 20 mm (0.79 in), 25 mm (0.98 in), and Tail Shank.





Tie realistic micro flies with true-to-life movement and take your trout and small fly fishing to the next level

- Shank system for creating virtually any highly articulated, small fly you desire.
- Co-developed with Blane Chocklett.
- 6~mm (0.24 in), 8~mm (0.31 in), and 6~mm (0.24 in) Tail Shank.





Specialized for use in intruder-style and other modern steelhead and salmon flies.

- Traditional salmon fly loop-up eye design.

- Stainless steel.
- Black, Blue, Copper-orange, Green, Pink.
- 25 mm (0.98 in), 40 mm (1.57 in).

Senvo's Articulated Micro Shank



Tie scaled-down articulated flies with lifelike movement.

- Your solution for tying trout spey flies such as petite trout wet flies, low-water steelhead flies, sparse streamer designs, and small traditional salmon flies.
- Co-developed with Greg Senyo.
- Stainless-steel wire slim enough to attach to #10 hooks.
- 17 mm (0.67 in), 23 mm (0.91 in).



Articulated Wiggle-Tail Shank



Add lifelike body movement to your nymphs.

- Easily tie articulated wiggle-tails or rear body sections on nymphs, emergers, small streamers and dry flies.
- Shank can be easily trimmed down to suit the size of fly you are tying or can be bent to put a curve in it.
- For flies in the #6 to #18 range.
- 20 mm (0.79 in).
