Pulcal is a beautiful farm, located in the valley near Antigua City. On this farm lie 80 year old avocado trees that draw the line of the plot of coffee we purchased. The farm faces an old house that Louis Pedro Zelaya's Auntie donated to the hospital, for a group of Nuns to use. This house is still active for social projects today.

The name of the farm comes from the word "Pulke" which is an alcoholic beverage that use to be made at the farm; it is similar to Mescal and Tequila. At the farm, there is a section that actively produces dairy products like milk and cheese.

All of the hard work that has been done by Louis Pedro and his cousin at the farm has paid off with this amazing coffee. This incredibly fresh lot has a rich, syrupy sweetness of dates and plum and vanilla flavours.
