

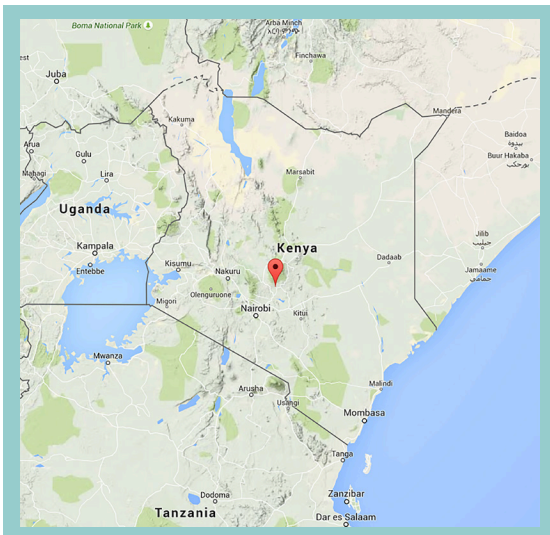


KENYA KIUNYU

The Kiunyu Coffee Factory is located within Ngariama region, Kabari sub-location in the Kirinyaga County and it is a member of the Karithathi Farmers' Cooperative Society. Kiunyu coffee factory was established in the 1960s and currently has 3,082 members.

Kiunyu is one of two coffee "factories" of the Karithathi Farmer Cooperative Society in Kianyaga town, in Kenya's highlands. A factory is a wet mill where cooperative farmers bring their coffee cherry fruits for processing. Kiunyu is situated at 1,644 meters of altitude and serves farmers in the villages of Kianduma, Kiambuku, Kiambatha, Gature and Kiamuki.

The region in which this coffee is grown has red volcanic soil, which is deep, fertile and well-drained; ideal for coffee production. Kiunyu Coffee factory is run by Joseph Musila, he works as a factory manager overseeing all activities within the factory. Together with other staff members, they carry out duties such as weighing coffee, selection and grading of coffee, paying farmers and addressing farmers' complaints.

This particular lot has a taste of hibiscus and rhubarb with a syrupy mouthfeel.
