SimSpace Home Golf Simulator Safety Guidelines

Introduction

1. Installation

- Frame Kit Assembly: Start by organising your frame kit by size and shape. - Professional Assistance: Although our kits are designed for straightforward assembly, we recommend that installation is carried out by at least two adults to ensure safety and accuracy.

2. Choosing the Right Location

- Space Requirements: Select a spacious, well-ventilated indoor area with minimal foot traffic. Ensure the space has at least 46 cm of clear space behind the impact screen, a tall ceiling of at least 3 metres for ceiling-mounted equipment, and sufficient horizontal clearance for a full golf swing.
- Safety Considerations: Consider whether children or pets will have access to the room. Using a closed room, baby gates, or exercise pens may be necessary to prevent accidents.

3. Installation Safety

• Follow Instructions Closely: Read all installation instructions and watch the provided video from start to finish before beginning your setup. Pay attention to safety tips and potential hazards noted in the documentation.

4. Equipment Setup

• Power Supply: Connect all electrical components to a surge protector. Organise cords to prevent tripping.

• Projector and Screen Setup: Securely mount projectors and ensure the screen is tightly fastened. Check regularly for wear and tear.

5. Play Safety

- Inspect Equipment: Before each use, inspect the equipment for any signs of damage or wear. Immediately replace damaged components.
