

Printable Ring Size Guide


For accuracy be sure this is printed to US Letter size and scaled to 100%. Check that the Reference Line measures 2 inches after printing. If not, adjust the printing scale up or down until the Reference Line measures exactly 2 inches.



OPTION 1: MEASURE A CURRENT RING

Choose a ring that fits your finger well. Lay the ring over the circles below.

The circle that fits inside your ring is your size. Make sure you can see the line completely. If some of the line is hidden, that size is too big.



OPTION 2: PRINT YOUR OWN RING SIZER

- 1. Cut out the ring sizer below.
- 2. Wrap the ring sizer snuggly around the widest part of the intended finger so that the numbers are visible to you, and insert the pointed end through the slot you made in the sizer.
- 3. Make note of the number that lines up with the slot, this is your ring size! Keep in mind that hand-stamped rings can stretch up to 1/2 size larger from the process of hand-stamping.

Tips:

Measure your finger later in the day (when it's at its largest).

Don't measure when it's cold (your finger will be smaller).
