

Off Licence

Sections 17 to 20, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the **Act**), **CHILLTER LIMITED** (the licensee) is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at **325C ESDAILE ROAD, TAURANGA 3180** and known as **THE BREWED NEST**, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises. The licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold **from** the premises at any time on any day (on line) and delivered somewhere else for consumption off the premises,
2. No alcohol is to be delivered from the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday or Christmas Day or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day;
3. No alcohol is to be delivered to the buyer (or to any other person on the buyer's behalf) at any time between 11:00pm and 6:00am the following day, on any day of the week;
4. The on site tasting and sales of mead is permitted on: **Thursdays 9.00am to 3.00pm and Fridays 9.00am to 6.00pm**
5. There must be a certificated manager properly appointed to the business by the licensee.
6. The Licensee must follow the procedures set out in Regulation 14 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Regulations 2013 to ensure that neither the purchaser, nor the person to whom alcohol is delivered, is a minor.
7. The Licensee must display on its website and/or in its catalogue and on every receipt issued for alcohol sold remotely:
 - a. the licence holder's name and licence number;
 - b. the date on which the licence expires;
 - c. a legible image of the licence, or a clearly identified link to such an image.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force—

- (a) either—
- (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either—
- (i) until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.

This licence continues in force until 30 June 2024 unless renewed.
