On the fourth floor of the Chateau, a room patiently awaited some TLC. The former servant's quarters boast a stunning view of the "Potagerie", the Chateau's walled garden.

The room waited nearly four years to receive the attention it deserved, and in that time, the Potagerie had begun its transformation – and the view got better and better and better. Dick duly named it "The Potagerie Suite", and from that moment on, the room began to come to life.

For Angel, design is about telling a story, and this one is about love.

"The kitchen garden is Dick's passion, and while tending to it is a little outside my comfort zone, I appreciate the beauty of everything that grows. With this design, I combine my admiration for Art Deco design with the produce lovingly cultivated by my husband. Carrots, courgettes, artichokes, sweet peas, and our bees feature in this bountiful celebration of the Potagerie. To complete the cottage garden feel, I drew inspiration from the flowers on the original century-old wallpaper in the room."









Nouveau Heron

The Nouveau Heron design is inspired by the heron that circles the moat at Chateau de la Motte Husson, brought to life in an Art Deco style.

In Japanese culture, the heron represents a noble and graceful appearance, a sign of purity and happiness. Surrounded by a picturesque moat, the Chateau is the perfect backdrop for this elegant and symbolic bird. The Nouveau Heron design beautifully encapsulates these qualities.

"We are very fortunate to be surrounded by a moat. Not only is it peaceful, but a heron perches on a rock every morning to catch fish. Dorothy has taken a real liking to our adopted heron, often shouting at the top of her lungs, 'The heron...the heron!' It usually flies away at this point, but we all run to the window to see it in flight!"












Emerald Fan

Emerald Fan features a vibrant colour palette of teal, light blue, and mustard - a stunning contrast that makes a bold statement. This richly opulent design is adorned with illustrated hand-held fans, intricate flowers, 1920s-inspired motifs, and Art Deco styling, creating a truly show-stopping aesthetic.

Inspired by Angel's love for traditional Japanese kimonos, Emerald Fan transports us to an era of glamour and effortless style. Angel originally created this design as wallpaper for her parent's new bedroom suite in the Coach House, a heartwarming renovation showcased in series 8 of Escape to the Chateau.

"I love a kimono! The moment I slipped on my first silky one, I was hooked, and 20 years later, my collection is vast. They are my go-to for comfort and effortless elegance, and I adore the intricate designs and sumptuous fabric. Drawing inspiration from this, Emerald Fan is a luxurious homage to the glamour of the roaring 20s and the romance of a bygone era."





The wild meadow and cutting garden at The Chateau tell a sweet love story. From the moment they met, Dick realised Angel's passion for flowers. Together with their children, Arthur and Dorothy, he made it their mission to create a magical space where wildflowers could grow.

Angel's floral design is characterised by this wild and abundant nature; she incorporates botanicals, herbs, and dried flowers into her arrangements for both The Chateau and weddings.

"The wild meadow and cutting garden hold a special place in my heart. The abundance of flowers and the creatures that inhabit them have inspired this whimsical yet elegant design. The Wildflower Garden captures the essence of the untamed surroundings with tendrils interweaving various shapes and forms to create an enchanting tapestry of beauty. A touch of Art Nouveau styling perfectly complements this expression of flora and fauna."





Woodland Trail

Take a stroll through the woodland at the Chateau, where you will encounter a variety of beautiful wildlife. The Woodland Trail is inspired by nature and features some of the flora and fauna you might see along the way.

The Strawbridge family shares the parkland with many species of wildlife. Angel captures some of these in this intricate design, while the autumnal tones reflect the colour palette of a particularly golden season at the Chateau.

"The grounds surrounding the Chateau are captivating and often become the subject of our morning chats while gazing staring out the window of the Strawbridge suite We feel so lucky to be able to take long walks, searching for deer, hedgehogs and squirrels hiding in the woodland. There is an abundance of natural beauty, and with Arthur and Dorothy at the perfect age, exploring nature is always on the agenda!"







The Lily Garden

A family outing to Monet's Garden inspired the creation of the moat's lily garden, beautifully captured in this striking print.

When searching for their forever home, being close to the water was at the top of the Strawbridge's must-have list. It was truly love at first sight when they saw the Chateau, and the moat was the icing on the cake.

It took them a couple of years before they ventured outside to plant their first trees. Since then, the grounds have served as a rich source of inspiration.

In 2019, the Strawbridges visited Monet's Gardens in Giverny. Captivated by the incredible beauty of the lily garden, they returned to the Chateau and planted 30 lily rhizomes. They could not believe it when, a couple of months later, the lilies produced week after week of stunning flowers.

"Sometimes, you draw inspiration from the beauty of other places to enhance your own home. Our whole family loved the lily pond at Giverny, so it felt natural to take this inspiration to our own moat. We watch the lilies change each day - who knew they only bloom after three hours of sunlight? When the sun sets, the lilies gently close and go to sleep. Isn't nature fascinating?"

- 2 width (recommended for a pair of 1 width curtains)
- 3 width (recommended for a pair of 1.5 width curtains)
- 4 width (recommended for a pair of 2 width curtains)
- 5 width (recommended for a pair of 2.5 width curtains)
- 6 width (recommended for a pair of 3 width curtains

- 46cm / 18" (recommended for a pair of 0.5-1 width curtains)
- 61cm / 24" (recommended for a pair of 1-1.5 width curtains)
- 76cm / 30" (recommended for a pair of 2-2.5 width curtains)
- 89cm / 35" (recommended for a pair of 3 width curtains)
