

A quick guide to assembling and caring for your end-lift ottoman

For the love of sleep

REMOVE ALL PLASTIC PACKAGING AND DO YOUR BEST TO RECYCLE! AVOID THE RISK OF SUFFOCATION, KEEP ALL PLASTIC BAGS AWAY FROM CHILDREN

END-LIFT OTTOMAN BASE

Your ottoman comes in two parts which must be properly joined together. The pistons are powerful so please make sure you have read all safety instructions.


Unbag both halves (remember to recycle the packaging), lay each half on its side and attach glides by inserting into each socket. Gently tap into place with a mallet (do not use a metal hammer as this will damage the glide).





Carefully turn both halves upright and then gently push down on the lid so that you can release the carabiner clips. Once released, ease the lid to its fully open position.


Push the two halves together in order to identify and line up the four bolt holes. Carefully pierce the fabric using the sticker as a guide.





Insert the two-part connecting bolts into the bolt holes on both sides and tighten.

Carefully pierce both sides of the lid. Insert single bolt and tighten.




We hope you're really pleased with your new ottoman which has been lovingly made by one of the UK's most well-known and respected bed makers. Please read the following guide carefully to ensure your bed is nice and stable and sits evenly.

STRUTTED HEADBOARD ATTACHMENT


Turn the struts to a vertical position by loosening the screws slightly at the top of the struts, just enough so you can move them. Once in position, fully tighten the bolts.






Locate the headboard fixing holes at the hinged end (marked with a sticker) and carefully pierce the fabric and insert the headboard bolt in to each hole. Do not tighten fully.

Slide headboard struts over the bolts and when in the correct position fully tighten the bolts, but don't overdo it!



FLOOR STANDING HEADBOARD ATTACHMENT

Locate the headboard fixing holes and pierce the fabric as described above. Then line up with the slots on the headboard, insert bolts and tighten.



OTTOMAN BASE CARE

STORAGE

The ottoman has been designed primarily to hold bed linen, clothing etc and has a limit of 50kg (25kg each side). So please distribute evenly and don't overload as excessive weight can damage the ottoman.

MAINTENANCE

Best to check the glides from time to time as they take the strain and may work loose. Make sure castors run freely and we recommend you protect your carpet or floor surfaces where the glides make contact

CLEANING

The surface may be lightly sponged with a weak solution of soap and water. Detergents or chemical cleaners are a definite no-no and should be avoided to prevent potential damage to the covering material.
