



Licence No: 30/OFF/1314/2023

PURSUANT to sections 17 to 20, and 64 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), HAWKE'S BAY INDEPENDENT BREWERY LIMITED (the licensee) is authorised to sell alcohol by remote sale from (but not on) the premises situated at 20 Awatoto Road Meeanee, Napier and known as Hawkes Bay Brewery Company, to any person for consumption off the premises and to deliver it or have it delivered by some other person somewhere else.

This licence is endorsed under section 40 of the Act, the licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

Pursuant to s215 of the Act the authority conferred by this licence need not be exercised through a manager appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act at all times.

## CONDITIONS

The licence is subject to the following conditions:

a. Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours when the premises are being operated as a remote sales site:

Any hour of any day.

b. No alcohol is to be **delivered** on:

Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1:00pm on Anzac Day, nor: At any time after 11:00pm on any day and before 6:00am on the next day.

- c. The following steps must be taken to promote the responsible consumption of alcohol:
  - The licensee must implement and maintain the steps proposed in their host responsibility policy.
- d. The following information must be displayed on the internet site in a prominent place, in any catalogue used by the license holder and on every receipt issued for any alcohol sold via the internet site:
  - i) The licence holders name, the licence number, and the date on which the licence expires.
  - ii) A copy of the licence or a clearly identified link to such an image must be displayed in a prominent place on the internet site.
- e. The following steps must be taken to verify that people are over the purchase age:
  - In the case of an <u>order made using an internet site, telephone order, or physical order</u> the prospective buyer must declare that he or she is 18 years of age or over (and where the prospective receiver is involved that the prospective receiver is also 18 years of age or over) -
    - once, when the prospective buyer first commences the order process; and
    - again, immediately before the sale of alcohol is completed.

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the renewal, suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence expires on:

19th day of September 2024
