Before you get started

Getting ready for glow in the dark rock painting is like prepping for a colorful adventure! Remember, it can get messy. So protect your space, wear old clothes that you don't mind getting paint on, keep paper towels handy, clean your rocks, have water for your brush. Now you're all set for rock painting fun!







Painting your Rocks

Each glow in the dark rock has a unique shape from nature. Before you begin, be sure to mix each paint color really well because paint can dry out over time.

Remember to mix the paint colors well and start with a base coat. Add more coats for darker colors. To make them glow, paint a layer of white first and then add your favorite colors. Let each coat dry before adding another.

Don't forget to wash and dry your paintbrush between coats or when changing colors. If colors fade over time, keep extra paint for touch ups, especially if your rocks are outside. Enjoy painting your glow in the dark rocks!

Using Glow in the Dark Paint

First, make sure the regular paint on your rock is completely dry.

- Get creative with the glow in the dark paint. Draw fun designs, lines and dots to make your rock look fantastic!
- Practice with glow in the dark paint on paper to see how it flows, it's a bit goopy, which is fun!
- After the paint dries, put it under a light for a bit, then turn off the lights to watch it glow.

Using Gems, Googly Eyes and Transfer Stickers

Ensure the rock is completely dry before adding gems, googly eyes, transfer or golden stickers. Choose your design, cut and peel of the clear film place the sticker on the rock. Dip the sponge in water, then gently press it on the transfer. Check if it's sticking to the rock, if not, wet it again. When you see it sticking, carefully peel off the paper's back, leaving the transfer on the rock. Don't touch it until it's all stuck on. Before you paint inside the transfer sticker, make sure the rock is super duper dry.
