Before you get started

Getting ready for glow in the dark shell painting is like prepping for a colorful adventure! Remember, it can get messy. So protect your space, wear old clothes that you don't mind getting paint on, keep paper towels handy, clean your shells, have water for your brush. Now you're all set for shell painting fun!

Painting your Shells

Each glow in the dark shell has a unique shape from nature. Before you begin, be sure to mix each paint color really well because paint can dry out over time.

Remember to mix the paint colors well and start with a base coat. Add more coats for darker colors. To make them glow, paint a layer of white first and then add your favorite colors. Let each coat dry before adding another.

Don't forget to wash and dry your paintbrush between coats or when changing colors. If colors fade over time, keep extra paint for touch ups, especially if your shells are outside. Enjoy painting your glow in the dark shells!

Using Glow in the Dark Paint

- 1** First, make sure the regular paint on your shell is completely dry.
- 2** Get creative with the glow in the dark paint. Draw fun designs, lines and dots to make your shell look fantastic!
- 3** Practice with glow in the dark paint on paper to see how it flows, it's a bit goopy, which is fun!
- 4** After the paint dries, put it under a light for a bit, then turn off the lights to watch it glow.

Using Gems and Googly Eyes

Make sure the shell is totally dry before applying any gems or googly eyes. Pick your design, peel it out and place it on the shell. Peel and press and let the shell shine! Find more shells and keep the glowing art going!
