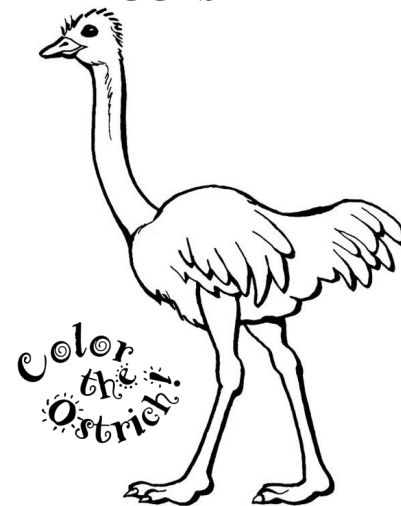

### The World's BIGGEST BIRD



What a strange, comical-looking bird! It has long legs, a high back, and a very small head. Some people call the OSTRICH the camel-bird because of its high back and humping walk, and like a camel, it can go a long time without water. It is very fast and powerful. It can run up to 50 miles per hour and outrun a horse. It can defend itself with a powerful forward kick that can disable a horse or a man. The male is quite handsome in its glossy black feathers and beautiful, white, wing and tail plumes. The expensive plumes were often used for ladies fine hats and other decorations.

Ostrich eggs are big and heavy, weighing about three pounds! The mother lays them in a hollow in the ground, which the father digs out with his big toes. Father has night-duty keeping the eggs warm, and mother has the day shift. When the chicks hatch, they are as large as barnyard hens! Whew! - the world's biggest baby birds, too!

## Kidz Heroez

### ADONIRAM JUDSON

Hero of India (1788-1850)



Born in 1788, Adoniram Judson was a brilliant child. He could read at three, mastered Greek at twelve, and graduated from college at nineteen with highest honors.

He had long resisted the Gospel, but after the restless, fearful death of an unbelieving friend, Judson accepted Christ and dedicated himself to missions.

India became his heart, but India was hostile to foreigners. People worshipped Buddha, and the emperor would not tolerate other religious teaching. It took many years to win the people's confidence. Judson suffered terrible illness and disease. With painstaking work, he translated the Bible into the Burmese language but was tortured unbelievably for his work and testimony. One time he spent 17 months in prison with his hands and feet bound to large bamboo poles. At night he was swung suspended upside-down by his feet tied to a high pole. His suffering from fever, burning heat, hunger, and torture tells his commitment to Christ. In 1850, too weak to walk, Mr. Judson was carried on board a ship to sail to France, but he died on the way and was buried at sea.

His labors still bear fruit today, and God will reward his faithfulness! - And now, what would God have you to do?

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
