## OSCAR OCTOPUS

It's great when Mom hugs you with two arms, but how would you like a hug with EIGHT arms? That could be a crusher!

Oscar Octopus has eight arms! He may not be the prettiest “kriiter” God made, but he surely is amazing! He lives in the sea and belongs to the mollusk family (clams, oysters, etc.), but he has no shell. Instead of a shell he has a muscular covering called a mantle. He has two eyes and three hearts! His arms (tentacles) extend out from his soft body. If he injures or loses one, he grows another in its' place. On the underside of each arm are muscular “suckers”. They look and work like suction cups to the octopus can attach himself to a rock or large fish or you! Some folks like to eat octopus meat, but if you do, I advise you not to turn the long arms over and look at the suckers while you are eating!

God gave him a great camouflage system. He can change color to blend with his surroundings. If an enemy comes, he squirts out a dark, inky fluid and makes a screen to hide himself. He can use that same dark screen to hide himself when fish come by. Then he can reach out and catch his supper!

## KIDZ HEROEZ D. L. MOODY (1837-1899)

Dwight Moody had a tough start in life. His father died early, leaving his wife with nine children, no means of support and staggering in debt. The heartless creditors took everything possible, including the kindling wood for their fire. Yet in such poverty, the children learned to give and shared their meager food with others. He had little chance for education. Saved at age 19, he started preaching. Someone said, “You should not speak in public. You make too many mistakes in grammar.” Moody replied, “I know I make mistakes and I lack many things, but I am doing the best with what I have. But look here friend, you’ve got grammar enough-what are you doing with it for the Master?”

He intended to go into business and make big money, but God turned his heart to preaching and winning souls. He opened Sunday Schools and missions in Chicago and other cities and reached out to win people to Christ! He was forceful, yet selfless. After the awful Chicago fire of 1871 burned out his church and home, he threw himself into relief work. During the Civil and Spanish-American Wars he tirelessly ministered to soldiers in camps and hospitals and stirred other Christians to help. He also started schools for the underprivileged and opened Bible Institutes.

In his great evangelistic meetings in America, Great Britain, and Palestine, he preached to over 15,000,000 people. When asked how many souls had been saved under his preaching, Moody answered, “I don’t know anything about that. Thank God, I don’t have to. I don’t keep the Lamb’s Book of Life.”

Moody’s constant plea was, “Let every one of us try to get one soul.” His son said, “Father lived solely for the glory of God and for the spread of the gospel of Jesus Christ.” There could be no greater tribute. –Young friend, will you try to live that way? Will you “try to get one soul” to the Savior? *He that winneth souls is wise* (Prov. 11:30).
