



After Jim died, Miss Betsy carried on alone at the Mission near the Indian reservation. It was barren land and the Native Americans needed help. Betsy continued to give out food, clothes and supplies. She never let anyone leave without telling them of Jesus' love and sacrifice for sinners. One morning as Betsy worked in her garden near a free range pasture, a massive bull suddenly came barreling through the fence into her yard like a bulldozer! Head down, nostrils blazing, he launched her into the air like a rocket, and she crash-landed head-first on the rocks! Everything was dark. She couldn't see. Blood trickled down her forehead and her eye was partly sticking out of its socket! Somehow she pushed it back in and could see faintly. An Indian couple came by and found Betsy in a helpless heap on the ground. They tried to stop the blood and called for help. An ambulance finally came and took her on the long trip to the hospital. It was a miracle she was still alive! She had many severe wounds and they wondered if she would live. The doctors said healing would take weeks, probably longer at her age (81). Not Betsy! After a short time, she was up and back "on duty". When asked how the doctor did it, she answered, "The doctor didn't do it: God did!"

God is still answering all of Miss Betsy's needs – her own and the Indians'. Betsy simply looks to Jesus, and "Jesus Never Fails".
