Handy Kit Keeps Supplies in One Place

First Aid - Kids -- they're always scraping their knees, bumping their noses or pinching their fingers in drawers.

Well, at least some kids are. That's where the Medibag by Me4Kids comes in handy.

Billed as a "real kid-friendly first aid kit, all purpose for home, auto, sports and more," the 117-piece red and white plastic box (made to look like an old-fashioned doctor's bag) contains a little of everything. You'll find bandages that look like crayons, antiseptic wipes, gauze pads, eyewash, ointment packs, burn relief gel, plastic tweezers, sting relief pads and more, more more.

One cool (pun intended) addition? An instant ice pack, ideal for pain relief caused by sprains or bee stings.

There are happy-face stickers, too, to help distract injured wee ones, as well as a small first aid guide from the American College of Emergency Physicians.

All products are latex-free, and the kit also comes with a coupon for a 45-item refill kit (you just have to pay the postage.)
