



Thank you for your purchase of item #75666 Firefly Solar Lantern. Please keep these instructions for future reference.

How the solar light works:

During the day, the solar panel converts solar power into the rechargeable battery. At night, the light turns on automatically using the stored energy. How long the light lasts depends on its location, weather conditions and seasonal lighting availability.

Choosing the right location:

An outdoor location with direct sunshine and where the solar panel of your light can receive at least 6 hours of sunshine each day is a good place for recharge. Using a shady location will influence the battery recharge and may shorten the working time of the light. The solar light should not be placed near lighting such as street light, which may cause the light to stop working, because solar light is light-sensitive and can automatically turn off once there is strong light source around.

Precautions:

Please note that light is designed to work when ambience the surrounding area becomes dark. If there are bright light sources nearby then the lamp might be very dim or not work at all. Although the manufacturer has charged the battery, the electric levels will have dropped when you receive it. Please charge it in a sunny location for a full day to optimize performance. The surface of the solar light must be kept clean, if not, this will influence the efficiency of charging.

How to use the solar light:

When you take out the solar lamp from the box, please find ON—OFF switch and turn to the “ON” position, then put the lamp into a sunny location. If you wish to conserve the solar charge you can turn to “OFF” after charging, and the light will only operate when you wish. If the light does not turn on automatically after 6 hours of charging please check the battery to ensure it is contacting the terminals. It is unusual, but possible, that the terminal contact can be interrupted in shipping.
