












## JOHN FRITH b. 1947

John was born in Hampshire England with a lifelong love of music. His earliest musical experiences were as a chorister and later, a Clarinetist. His musical education began at Dartington College of Arts in South Devon where he studied composition with Richard Hall and the French Horn. Then to London and the Guildhall School of Music and Drama to further his studies with Edmund Rubbra and Anthony Halstead for composition and the Horn (respectively) winning the Brass & School Composition prizes in 1970 and 1971.

After a few years as a professional Horn prayer, John made the decision to focus on his teaching and composition. His published output includes choral, instrumental and orchestral music much of which have been professionally recorded and some broadcast by the BBC.
