Kenneth Knowles graduated from the University of Toronto with a Bachelors of Music having studied the Trombone with Ralph Sauer. He obtained his Masters in Music Performance on Trombone at the Eastman School of Music studying with Emory Remington. His performance background as a Trombonist ranges from jazz appearances with Ella Fitzgerald to symphonic concerts with the Toronto Symphony and National Arts Centre Orchestras.

His arrangements for brass have been performed in concert and on radio throughout Canada and the USA.

At Memorial University School of Music in St. John's Newfoundland, his main teaching areas were the low brass instruments, orchestration, arranging and chamber music. Knowles retired in 2004 after twenty years as a professor of music at Memorial University.

He still lives near in Newfoundland and is an avid ornithologist, often lecturing on specialty cruise expeditions.
