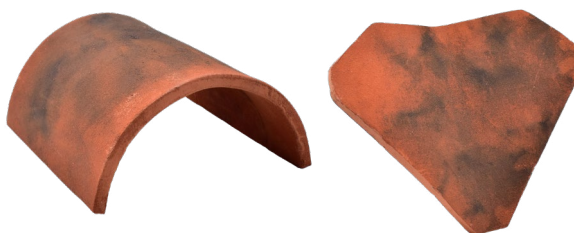


The Goxhill Plain Tile Restoration Blend is the perfect addition to our richly textured Goxhill handmade colour range.
