## RECIPE FOR CARE.

This yarn is designed to have a low pilling\* quotient however, its tough to avoid forever. Pilling occurs as a natural result of friction. A careful snip with scissors will restore your item to its original glory. If required, gently hand wash in cold water then lay flat in the shade to dry.

Handle with care and try not to bring into contact with sharp objects.

\*Pilling does not constitute a defect

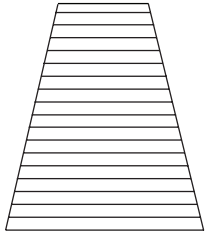
## RECIPE INSPIRATION.



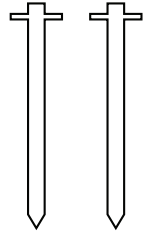
## battered popcorn blanket - large.

approx 160cm x 130cm

### ingredients.



5 x 2ply bumps



1 x set of 45mm needles

### abbreviations.

**k** - Knit

**p** - Purl

**popcorn** - k into front and then back of the next stitch twice, slip the 2nd, 3rd, and 4th stitches over the 1st. Push popcorn to front before continuing to knit.



### recipe.

cast on 25 stitches

row 1: k

row 2: p

row 3: k3, \*popcorn, k5\* popcorn, k3

row 4: p

row 5: k

row 6: p

row 7: k6, \*popcorn, k5\* popcorn, k6

row 8: p

row 9-40: rows 1 -8 is pattern, repeat 4 more times

row 41: k

row 42: p

row 43: k3, \*popcorn, k5\* popcorn, k3

row 44: p

row 45: k

cast off

block blanket and shape to size
