

PATTERN NOTES.

RECIPE FOR CARE.

This yarn is designed to have a low pilling* quotient however, its tough to avoid forever. Pilling occurs as a natural result of friction. A careful snip with scissors will restore your item to its original glory. If required, gently hand wash in cold water then lay flat in the shade to dry.

Handle with care and try not to bring into contact with sharp objects.

*Pilling does not constitute a defect

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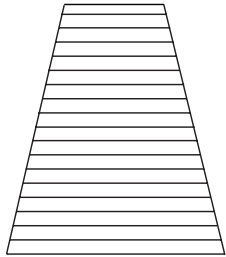

candy cane blanket.

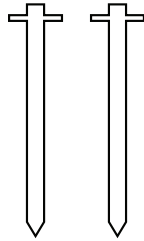
approx 100 x 185cm

ingredients.



4 x 1ply bumps

3 x colour a - white | 1 x colour b - red



1 x set of 45mm needles



recipe.

cast on 24 stitches

- row 1-4: knit all (A)
row 5: k8 (A) * (B) k16
row 6: k16 (B) ** (A) k8
row 7: k8 (A) ** (B) k16
row 8: k16 (B) ** (A) k8
row 11-16: knit all (A)
row 17: k18 (B) * (A) k6
row 18: k6 (A) ** (B) k18
row 19: k18 (B) ** (A) k6
row 20: k6 (A) ** (B) k18
row 21: k18 (B) ** (A) k6
row 22: k6 (A) ** (B) k18
row 23: k18 (B) ** (A) k6
row 24: k6 (A) ** (B) k18
row 25-28: knit all (A)

cast off

- * join the new yarn colour by knotting it onto the existing yarn colour.
Do not cut working yarn.
- ** pass the yarn you are about to knit with back between the needles.
Wrap new colour under the yarn you were knitting with. Knit a stitch
with the new colour to capture the previous yarn.
