PATTERN NOTES.

RECIPE FOR CARE.

This yarn is designed to have a low pilling* quotient however, its tough to avoid forever. Pilling occurs as a natural result of friction. A careful snip with scissors will restore your item to its original glory. If required, gently hand wash in cold water then lay flat in the shade to dry.

Handle with care and try not to bring into contact with sharp objects.

*Pilling does not constitute a defect





ribbed crochet rug pattern.

approximately 60cm diameter

Rug is worked in a spiral using either a crochet hook or by hand crochet. Each single crochet from round 2 onwards, is created in the back loop of the stitch underneath, to create the ribbed look.

ingredients.







1 x crochet hook



1 large stitch marker

abbreviations.

SK – slip knot Ch – chain SC – single crochet SS – slip stitch

recipe.

Make a loose SK.

Ch 2

round 1: SC 6 times into SK. Gently pull the yarn tail to tighten the SK. Place a stitch marker into top of last SC in this round. [6 SC]

round 2: 2SC in BACK loop of each SC in round 1. Move stitch marker into top of last SC in this round [12 SC].

round 3: *2SC in first stitch, SC in next stitch* [6 times]. Move stitch marker to top of last stitch in this round [18 SC].

round 4: *2SC in first stitch, SC in next two stitches* [6 times]. Move stitch marker to top of last stitch in this round [24 SC].

round 5: *2SC in first stitch, SC in next three stitches* [6 times]. Move stitch marker to top of last stitch in the round [30 SC].

**Continue to crochet spiral rounds increasing in this manner until the rug is the desired size, finishing at your stitch marker. SS once into next SC, to finish off the final round. Tie off yarn and secure both yarn tails on the back side of the rug.
