RECIPE FOR CARE.

This yarn is designed to have a low pilling* quotient however, its tough to avoid forever. Pilling occurs as a natural result of friction. A careful snip with scissors will restore your item to its original glory. If required, gently hand wash in cold water then lay flat in the shade to dry.

Handle with care and try not to bring into contact with sharp objects.

*Pilling does not constitute a defect






4 x 2ply bumps

1 x set of 45mm needles



recipe.

cast on 24 stitches

row 1: k1, *wyif sl 2, k2*; rep* to * until last st, k1

row 2: k1, *p1, wyib sl 2, p1*; rep* to * until last st, k1

row 3: k1, *k2, wyif sl 2*; rep* to * until last st, k1

row 4: k1, *wyib sl 1, p2, wyib sl 1*; rep* to * until last st, k1

row 1-4 is pattern, repeat pattern twice for rows 5-12

row 13: k1, *k2, wyif sl 2*; rep* to * until last st, k1

row 14: k1, *p1, wyib sl 2, p1*; rep* to * until last st, k1

row 15: k1, *wyif sl 2, k2*; rep* to * until last st, k1

row 16: k1, *wyib sl 1, p2, wyib sl 1*; rep* to * until last st, k1

row 13-16 is pattern, repeat twice for rows 17-24

cast off

add tassels to your heart's desire!
