

# PATTERN NOTES.

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## RECIPE FOR CARE.

This yarn is designed to have a low pilling\* quotient however, its tough to avoid forever. Pilling occurs as a natural result of friction. A careful snip with scissors will restore your item to its original glory. If required, gently hand wash in cold water then lay flat in the shade to dry.

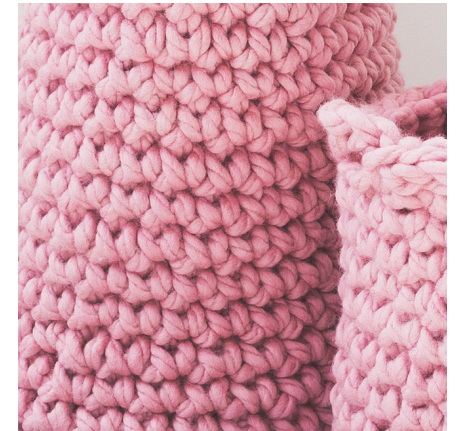
Handle with care and try not to bring into contact with sharp objects.

\*Pilling does not constitute a defect

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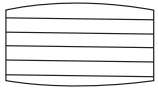
## RECIPE INSPIRATION.



## medium hanging storage.

approx 30cm x 32cm

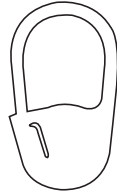
### ingredients.



3 x 2ply cheeses



1 x 19mm crochet hook



1 stitch marker

### abbreviations. (US terms)

ch – chain

sc – single crochet

st/sts – stitch/stitches

sl st – slip stitch



### recipe.

Make a magic ring OR ch 3, sl st into first ch to make ring

row 1: ch 1, 6 sc into ring, join with sl st (6sc)

row 2: ch 1, 2 sc into each st, join with sl st (12 sc)

row 3: ch 1, [\*2 sc into next st, 1 sc into next st], repeat from \* then join with sl st (18 sc)

row 4: ch 1, [\*2 sc into next st, 1 sc into next 2 st], repeat from \* then join with sl st (24 sc)

row 5: sc into each st around until you reach marker, remove marker, sc, place maker into sc

row 6 – 16: repeat row 5 (11 times)

row 17: chain 3, sl st into each sc until you reach marker

fasten off
