WARNING

- Make sure the users of this product are knowledgeable on its proper operation. The product is ready for use only when all locking mechanisms are engaged. Check carefully that these are engaged before use.
- When the child is left unattended in the product, in "crib mode", and the zippers are completely closed.
- When the products is being used especially in "crib mode", all opening, adjusting, anchoring and positioning operations of the product must be carried out exclusively by an adult.
- Before use in "Co-sleeping mode, make sure the product is properly anchored and positioned.

A WARNING

- When the product is used in "Co-sleeping mode, before laying the child in it, the product must be secured to the parents' mattress and no gaps between the products and the adults' mattress must be present.
- The product must always be placed on a horizontal surface. Never leave the product on an inclined surface with the child inside of it.
- Children must not be permitted to play without supervision near the product.
- Do not use the product without the frame.
- The thickness of the mattress must be such that the vertical height (upper surface of the mattress until the upper edge of the product's sides) is at least 200mm. Do not use more than one mattress in the crib.
- If you purchase a mattress separately, make sure it is suitable for the product.
- The reference mark on the product's interior indicates the maximum thickness of the mattress that shall be used.
- Do not leave any object inside the product that could reduce its depth.
- Do not position the cot near walls and obstacles to prevent choking hazards.
- Use only spare parts approved by the manufacturer. Do not apply accessories to the product, which are not supplied by the manufacturer.
- Do not adjust the product with the child inside.
- Do not move the product with the child inside.
- Do not use the product with more than one child at a time.
- The product must be kept away from electric cables and cords: do not place the
 product near windows where cords, curtains or similar objects could pose chocking
 or strangling hazards for the child. To avoid strangling hazards, do not give to your
 child or place near him, objects equipped with cords.

COMPONENTS

- A. Support leg with wheels
- B. Support leg with non-slip feet
- C. Central supporting structure
- D. Fixing belts
- E. Fabric lining with Mattress
- F. Strorage basket


ASSEMBLY OF THE CRIB

- Open the frame leg (fig.2), position the frame with fabric lining as showed in (fig2).
- Fix the central supporting structure to the 2 legs as illustrated in (fig. 3), The CLICK of the pivot indicates correct fixing of the structure (fig.5)
- Fix the down supporting structure to the two legs as illustrated in (fig.5), The CLICK of the pivot indicates correct fixing of the structure (fig.4).
- Fasten the fabric to the supporting tube as showed in (fig.6), attach storage basket as showed in (fig.7).
- Position the mattress on the bottom of the crib.(fig.8), Press and hold the button (fig9).
- Prop up the frame as illustrated in (fig.10).
- At this point the crib is ready to use (fig.11).

▲ WARNING check to make sure that all of the fasteners have been correctly. attached and that the zips are closed and locked right to the end of their travel.

HEIGHT ADJUSTMENT OF THE COT

- Height of baby crib:
 - 1.48-50cm
 - 2.45-48cm
 - 3.42-45cm
 - 4.39-42cm
 - 5.36-39cm
 - 6.35-36cm
- The crib can be adjusted to different height positions. In order to adjust the height, pull the adjustment lever sides upwards (fig12), and lift the crib to the desired position. Repeat this operation on the opposite side.
- The base of the crib can inclined slightly by adjusting the 2 legs to different heights (fig.13).
- ▲ WARNING the crib can be inclined with a maximum variance of 2 positions between one leg and the other (fig.13).
- ▲ WARNING The head of the child should always be positioned on the highest side. (fig.13).





CO-SLEEPER MODE

The crib can be used next to parent bed (co-sleeping mode).

WARNING: IMPORTANT FOR THE SAFETY OF YOUR CHILD: this method is only possible with bed types that comply with all of the conditions described in this paragraph.

WARNING: THE GAP BETWEEN PARENT BED AND BABY CRIB MUST NOT BE BIGGER THAN 13MM.

ALWAYS KEEP THE BABY CRIB AND ADULT BED IS HORIZONAL AS SHOWED ON BELOW PICTURE.

Always make sure baby crib open side rail no longer higher (at or below) adult bed height range during bedside mode.




This bedside sleeper is designed for use only with adult beds that are between 34cm to 49cm from floor to top of adult mattress.

This product can not be used with adult bed that mattress, box springs not in line with the frame.

This product can be used with adult bed that mattress, box spring in line with frame. see below picture.

A bedside sleeper is designed to provide a sleeping area for an infant until he or she begins to push up on hands and knees or approximately5 months of age. Move your child to another sleeping product when your child reaches this stage.

WARNING: Do not use this bassinet if you cannot exactly follow the accompanying instructions. Failure to follow

these warnings and instructions could result in

serious injury or death.

SUFFOCATION HAZARD Infants have suffocated:

- In gaps between extra padding, a mattress (too small or too thick) and product sides.
- On soft bedding. Use only the pad provided by the manufacturer that is no thicker than 25 mm (1 in) and is of such a size that, when pushed against any side of the product, it does not leave a gap of more than 25 mm (1 in) between the mattress and sides.
- NEVER add a pillow, comforter, or another mattress for padding. FALL HAZARD: To help prevent falls, DO NOT use this product when the infant begins to push up on hands and knees, or can roll over, or has reached manufacture's recommended maximum weight of 6.9kg (15lb), whichever comes first.
- Always use product on the floor. Never use on an elevated surface.
- To reduce the risk of SIDS, pediatricians recommend healthy infants be placed on their backs to sleep, unless otherwise advised by your physician.
- Always attach all provided fasteners tightly according to the instruction. Check frequently. Do not use if there are any loose or missing parts or signs of damage. Do not substitute parts. Contact the manufacturer for replacement parts.
- Toys are not to be "mouthed" by the baby and should be positioned clearly out of reach of the baby's face and mouth.
- Do not place medication, small toys, small items, cords, straps or similar items that could become wound around the child's neck in or near this product and do not place product near a window, blind, patio door, heater, or power outlet.
- If a sheet is used with the pad use only the one provided by manufacturer or one specifically the dimension of the bassinet mattress.
- To avoid death from the infant's neck being caught on the top rail on the side that is next to the adjlt bed, the top rail must be no higher than the adult bed mattress.

The attachment system must ALWAYS be used in bedside sleeper mode.



In particular the side support of the crib should always be put close to the Parent's mattress and the mattress should always be aligned with the height of the side support for restraint of the crib.

WARNING: Check to make sure that the crib in the co-sleeping mode does not interfere with the parent's bed.

WARNING: During use, make sure that the parents bed sheets, blankets etc. Do not enter and cover the interior of the crib.

- Open the side of the crib with the window using the side zips and open them completely (fig.14).
- Then press the removable tubular structure release button and remove partially on one side and then on the other (fig15.16.17).

WARNING: use the crib with the tube lowered, only in the co-sleeping Mode.

• Move the crib close to the parent's bed and check the height of crib compared with the mattress of the bed.

WARNING: the height of the parent's mattress should always be more than that of the side support for containment of the crib.

WARNING: in the co-sleeping mode the 2 legs of the crib should always be adjusted to the same height.

Entrapment Hazard—To prevent death from entrapment, bedside sleeper must be properly secured to adult bed using the attachment system.

- (1) There must be no more than 1/2 in. (13 mm) gap between bedside sleeper and adult bed.
- (2) Check tightness before each use by pulling bedside sleeper in a direction away from adult bed.
- (3) If gap exceeds 1/2 in. (13 mm), DO NOT use product.
- Do not fill the gap with pillows, blankets or other items that are suffocation hazards.
- (4) <u>Assemble product according to manufacturer's instructions for ANY use modebedside sleeper as well as the bassinet or play yard modes, or both.</u>
- (5) Always use ALL required parts for each use mode.
- Check instruction manual for a list of required parts. Periodically check product for loose, damaged, or missing parts.
- (6) To avoid death from the infant's neck being caught on the top rail on the side that is next to the adult bed, the top rail must be no higher than the adult bed mattress.



WARNING: The attachment strap must always be used in bedside sleeper mode.

WARNING: Use of the product is only permitted with beds and/or mattresses with straight sides. Use of the product with round beds and/or mattresses or water beds is not permitted. WARNING: When the product is used in the Co-Sleeping Mode (it should always be positioned next to the long side of access to the bed. DO NOT position the product to the head or bottom of the bed.)

The cot do not swing: In order to make it stable on the flat level when baby in the crib, we have two support frame on the base of cot, to ensure the baby not drop down and never swing on the crib cot;

WARNING: This crib swing function must be operated by adult, whenever before the adult left, he must close the swing function in order not to make crib rollover.

MAINTENANCE ADVICE

The crib and the mattress have a resistant fabric cover, which is completely removable and Washable.

The removal/application activities should be carried out by adults only. On a regular basis check the condition of the product and the presence of any possible damage. In the case of damage do not use it and keep it out of the reach of children. For washing of the fabrics, carefully comply with the instructions indicated on the label.

For cleaning do not use solvents, abrasive products or aggressive products. After each wash check the resistance of the fabric and of the stitching



Hand wash in cold water



Do not bleach



Do not tumble dry



Do not iron



Do not dry cleaning

WARNING: During the removal and/or application of the lining, handle the fabric carefully in order to avoid accidental damage or tears.

WARNING: The removal and/or application operations may take a few minutes and should be carried out by an adult

REMOVE LINING


- Open the side of the crib with the window using the side zips and open them completely (fig.19/20).
- Then press the removable tubular structure release button and remove partially on one side and then on the other (fig.21/22).
- Unfasten the velcro as showed in (fig 23).
- Open the zip located on the upper edge of the crib (fig 24/25) and remove the fabric lining completely(fig.26).

REMOVE LINING

• The crib can be fully disassembled . To disassemble the crib, repeat the operations from back to front described in assembly of the crib.

BEDSIDE SLEEPER MODE AND THE STATEMENT:

- DO NOT use beside sleeper if any parts are missing, damaged, or broken, please contact BABY CITY for replacement parts and instructional litterture if needed. DO NOT substitute parts.
- Keep instruction book for future use.
- Always read and follow assembly instructions for each product use model: (Bedside sleeper, bassinet, play yard.)




ATTACHMENT & STRAP

Use of attachment system (strap) instruction:

- 1. Insert the buckle as showed in picture 1.
- 2. Thread the belt as showed in picture 2.
- 3. Insert the other side of buckle to X showed in picture 3.
- 4. Adjust the attachment belt closely to adult bed as showed in picture 4.











ATTACHMENT SYSTEM MUST ALWAYS BE USED IN BEDSIDE SLEEPER MODE.
