
How To Measure Your Fireplace



Fireplace Opening Dimensions This is just the basic opening size of your fireplace that lets us know what size to make your door.

- 1. Measure your Top Opening Width
- 2. Measure your Bottom Opening Width
- 3. Measure your Left Side Height
- 4. Measure your Right Side Height

Surround Dimensions -

The "surround" is anything that sticks out around the fireplace cavity that could interfere with the fireplace door overlap.

- 5. Measure from the Top Opening upwards
- 6. Measure your Left Side Opening to the left
- 7. Measure your Right Side Opening to the right


Obstructions (check all that apply)

- Projecting Brick
 - Recessed Opening
- Rotary Damper Control
- Keystone
- No Hearth Extension/Raised Firebox
- Wood Mantle
- Marble Mantle Surround
- Opening Terminates at Wall
- Dropped Firebox
 - Picture Frame Mounting

Height to Lintel



We measure this to make sure our interior fitting doors and installation hardware will work in your fireplace.

- 1. Locate the LINTEL and measure from the front of the lintel to the FRONT OF FIREPLACE. (Not all fireplaces have one. If yours doesn't that is OK. You can skip this section).
- 2. Measure from the top of the fireplace (usually BRICK but not always) to the HEARTH or the floor of the FIREPLACE CAVITY.
- 3. Measure from the bottom of the LINTEL to the HEARTH or the floor of the FIREPLACE CAVITY.
