## Explanation of Symbols

Please read the following safety precautions as they are designed to prevent unexpected danger and damage.

These safety precautions are divided into two sections, Warning statements and Caution statements.

A WARNING	
Indicates a potentially hazardous situation which, if not avoided, could result in serious injury.	Indicates a potentially hazardous situation which, if not avoided, may result in minor or moderate personal injury, or property damage.



### **Important Safety Instructions**

### 

It is important that you follow the instruction as mentioned in this manual. Failure to follow the instructions laid down in this manual may cause serious injury.

- Dispose the packing materials safely to keep them out of the reach of children.
- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the product. To reduce the risk of injury, close supervision is necessary.
- Do not use device except for intended application.
- Do not cover the device with anything which affects normal heat dissipation. This may lead to malfunction of the device or cause fire.
- Do not operate in an enclosed environment, such as a pocket, backpack or carry case.
- Do not leave the device unattended when it is switched on.
- Do not use or store firearms, combustibles or inflammables near the product.
- Do not store the product with dead battery for long time. Li-ion battery products need to charge at least once every 3 months.
- Stores the device at room temperature & in dry environment.
- Do not touch the moving parts.
- Do not immerse device in water or any other liquids or place in dishwasher.
- Do not use the product in rain, near washbasins, or other wet locations when it is charging.
- Do not use or charge the product when it is wet. If the product has been submerged, stop using the product.
- Avoid wetting the outer surface of the device. If it does get wet during operation, or even when not in operation, dry it immediately.
- In case USB Charging Lid gets wet, turn off charging lid before cleaning and allow it to dry thoroughly before turning it on again.
- Do not attempt to dry the product with an external heat source, such as microwave oven or hair dryer.
- Do not put insert metal or foreign objects in the product.
- Do not disassemble the battery and try to repair or modify the device by yourself.
- Do not dismantle, crush, puncture and short circuit battery, or expose it to liquids, fire or environment with the temperature above 60°C (140°F).

#### **Mosquito Repeller**

- Do not cover the Mosquito Repeller when it is in use.
- Do not use Mosquito Repeller in an environment where there is little air circulation.
- Do not expose the Mosquito Repeller to temperature above 50°C.
- Do not immerse Mosquito Repeller in water.

#### Air Pump

- If the Air Pump makes an unusual sound while running or it starts to overheat, turn if off immediately.
- keep your eyes away from the inflation or deflation port when device is working.
- Do not continuously use Air Pump for more than 10 minutes.
- Do not immerse Air Pump in water.
- Always keep the inflation & deflation port of Air Pump clean.

#### **Coffee Grinder**

- Do not put anything in Bean Hopper except coffee beans.
- Make sure there are no foreign objects inside the coffee grinder before use.
- Make sure to pull down the Retractable Powder Container before grinding each time.
- Make sure to put the coffee bean hopper back in place after filling the hopper with coffee beans and before turning on the grinder.
- Do not touch the burr when the grinder is in operation.
- Do not use the grinder if it appears damaged or attempt to repair, modify or dissemble the unit.

#### Lantern Mood Light

• Do not look into the lantern directly for a long period when it is in use to avoid eye injury.


- This product is not a toy and is intended for adult use only.
- Improper use of device may cause damage to device or personal injury.
- This product contains a lithium ion battery which is subject to certain transport restrictions.
- The lithium rechargeable battery used in this charging device may present a risk of fire or chemical burn with improper use. Do not disassemble, short circuit, crush, expose to heat above 60°C or incinerate. Do not operate outside of its operating temperature range of 0°C to 40°C. Misusing or incorrectly connecting the charging device may cause electric shock to users and damage to the device. Read instructions carefully. The Power Bank may become warm and may reach 50°C under extended high-power operation. During operation, keep the charging device away from materials that may be affected by high temperatures. Follow manufacturer instructions.
- When disposing the product, make sure that the product is not connected to the battery and the battery has completely discharged.
- For used mosquito pads, place them in trash can properly.

This product contains a built-in rechargeable battery which should not be disposed of with normal household waste. At the end of its service life, it must be disposed of a collection point for recycling electrical and electronic devices.








## Locking & Unlocking the Modules






Other modules can be locked and unlocked with the same method



### Battery (Standard & Premium)



### Fully charge the battery before use


Open the USB silicon cover and plug in USB Type-C cable for charging

### While charging...

LED Indicator is **breathing**. (refer to the following LED Battery Indicator)

### **Fully charged**

Red LED turns *steady* after charging is complete\*



#### \* Standard Battery - 2.6 hrs / Premium Battery - 9 hrs (charging from 0-100%)

### **LED Battery Indicator**




**75% - 100%** All 4 White LEDs turn on



**50% - 75%** 3 White LEDs turn on




25% - 50% 2 White LEDs turn on



1 **% - 25%** 1 Red LED turns on

### **Check the battery level**

Double press the Power Button on battery to check the remaining battery level



## **Mosquito Repeller**

### **Repellent Pad Installation**

Insert the repellent pad into the heating plate slot as shown below



### **Power Mode selection**

After the battery is activated, the initial mode is half power mode and Red LED light is flashing


Press the Power Mode Button once (1-press) to change to full power mode and the RED LED light turns steady

### **Turning off the Mosquito Repeller**

Double press the Power Button on battery until White LED light turns off

### Replacing and charging the repellent pad

Make sure device is off and completely cooled down. Push out the used pad by inserting a new one



### A Warning:

Do not put device in the water. Keep out of reach of children.


Do not touch or insert foreign objects in the heating area.

Do not use where there is little air circulation.

Do not expose the repeller module to the temperature over 50°C.



## Lantern & Mood Light



### **Turning On the Lantern & Mood Light**


Double press the **Power Button** on battery until the White LED turns on

### Turning Off the Lantern & Mood Light

Double press the **Power Button** on battery until the White LED turns off

### To switch between multiple lighting modes:

Turn on the power of Lantern & Mood Light by double pressing the Power Button on battery. Double press **Mode button** for switching between different modes according to the following sequences: *Lantern Light -> Mood Light -> Camp Fire Light -> SOS Light* 





## Lantern & Mood Light (Cont'd...)

### Lantern Light Mode

### Select color (Cool - Warm White Color)

- 1. Color changes between cool and warm white color once entering the Lantern Light Mode
- 2. Press the Mode Button once (1-press) to start the color change
- 3. When reaching desired color, press the Mode Button once (1-press) to stop the color change

### Adjust brightness level

- 1. Press and hold the Mode Button (1-press and hold) and the brightness level changes between dimmest and brightest
- 2. Release the Mode Button to stop when desired brightness is reached

### Mood Light Mode

### Select color (rainbow color spectrum)

1. Color changes in loop as below sequence once entering the Mood Light Mode

( Red -> Orange -> Yellow -> Green -> Light Green -> Blue -> Purple )

- 2. Press the Mode Button once (1-press) to start the color change
- 3. When reaching desired color, press the Mode Button once (1-press) to stop the color change

### Adjust brightness level


- 1. Press and hold the Mode Button (1-press and hold) and the LED brightness level changes between dimmest and brightest
- 2. Release the Mode Button to stop when reaching the desired brightness

Camp Fire Mode for extra fun in the wild

**SOS Mode** for emergency use only

\*LED light color and brightness setting (in Lantern Light and Mood Light Mode) will be saved automatically after 3s without turning off the power


## **Coffee Grinder**



Retractable Powder Container

### Be sure to pull down the Retractable Powder Container before grinding!!

Hold the Grinder Body firmly with one hand. Pull down the Retractable Powder Container and lock as below:



### **Turning On the Coffee Grinder**

Double press the Power Button on battery until the White LED turns on

### **Turning Off the Coffee Grinder**


Double press the Power Button on battery until the White LED turns off



### Coffee Grinder (Cont'd...)

### Removing coffee powder from container

Turn off the battery power. Hold the Grinder Body firmly with one hand and unlock the Coffee Powder Container as below:



### **A**Warning:

Always turn off the grinder before opening the bean hopper or retractable container. Do not touch the burr when the grinder is in operation. Do not use the grinder if it appears damaged or attempt to repair, modify or dissemble the unit. Do not put anything in Bean Hopper except coffee beans.



## Air Pump



### **Adaptor selection**


Choose the correct nozzle provided to deflate or inflate

### Turning on the Air Pump

Double press the Power Button on the battery until White LED light turns on

### **Turning off the Air Pump**

Double press the Power Button on the battery until White LED light turns off



### **A** Warning:

Do not use more than 10 mins continuously to avoid overheating. Children under the age 12 must be supervised by adult when using the pump. Please check if the devices are functioning properly before use. Keep your eyes away from the inflation port or deflation port when device is working.



### **Power Bank**

### **Charging with USB cable**


Open the silicon cover on the back of the Power Bank, connect with USB cable and your device to charge

### **Turning on the Power Bank**

Double press the Power Button on the battery until the White LED turns on

### **Turning off the Power Bank**

Double press the Power Button on the battery until the White LED turns off



### **A** Warning:

Do not attempt to repair or modify the Power Bank Module.

Do not use the power bank in rain, wash basins or wet locations.

In case this Power Bank gets wet, turn it off immediately. Allow it to dry thoroughly before turning it on again. Do not dry it with external heat sources such as microwave, oven or hair dryer.



## **Cleaning and Maintenance**

### General

- If the device does not function properly, turn it off and check the troubleshooting on p.18–19.
- Always turn off the device before cleaning.
- Do not immerse the product in water or other liquids.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners or chemical solvents.
- Do not wash the device under running water.
- If the surface of device becomes dirty, clean it with a moist soft cloth.
- Do not store the product with dead battery for long time. Li-ion battery products need to charge at least once every 3 months.
- Stores the devices at room temperature & in dry environment.

#### Air Pump

- Ensure there are no foreign objects inside inflation or deflation port before use.
- Make sure to turn the device off before cleaning the ports.

#### **Coffee Grinder**

- Do not store coffee beans in the Coffee Bean Hopper after use.
- Ensure there are no foreign objects inside the Coffee Grinder before use.
- Clean the parts of Coffee Grinder regularly.
- Before cleaning any part of the coffee grinder (even the outer shell), make sure it is turned off.
- Do not clean the grinder under running water or submerge it in water.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners or chemical solvents to clean the grinder.



## Troubleshooting

#### This section summarizes the most common problems encountered.

Modula	Symptoms	Suggested Solutions
Battery (Standard /	No operation	Double press the power button to operate and make sure the battery is fully charged.
(Standard / Premium)	No charging	Reconnect the charger to the charging terminal and make sure the charging source is in operation.
Air Pump	No operation	<ol> <li>Check if the fan is stuck or blocked</li> <li>Check if the device is locked with the battery.</li> <li>Double press the power button again and make sure the battery is not drained.</li> <li>Make sure the pump adaptor is securely connected.</li> </ol>
Mosquito Repeller	No operation	<ol> <li>Check if the device is locked in proper position with the battery.</li> <li>Double press the power button again and make sure the battery is not drained.</li> <li>If the repellent pad turns white from pale blue, replace with a new one.</li> </ol>
	No operation	<ol> <li>Check if the device is locked in proper position with the battery.</li> <li>If Coffee bean hopper is not in locking position, make sure the hopper triangle symbol aligns with the lock symbol.</li> <li>Double press the power button again and make sure the battery is not drained.</li> </ol>
Coffee Grinder	Grinder get stuck	<ol> <li>Make sure the hopper is not overloaded with beans.</li> <li>Grind the beans in coarse setting first, followed by grinding in finer setting.</li> <li>Make sure no foreign object is in the coffee beans hopper. Follow the grinder cleaning instructions to remove the foreign object.</li> <li>Battery may be out of power; fully charge the battery.</li> </ol>
Lantern Mood Light	No operation	<ol> <li>Check if the device is locked in proper position with the battery.</li> <li>Make sure to double press the power button of the battery and that the battery is not drained.</li> </ol>
