

HELPFUL TIPS

- Skinny guinea pigs have no fur and delicate skin, so they need special care, and should be handled more gently
- + Use soft, absorbent paper bedding and hides, chews, and toys without sharp edges to avoid injuries and skin irritations
- + Spot clean habitat daily and deep clean once a week
- + Do not bathe, as their skin is protected by natural oils

PFUN FACTS

- Nearly hairless, this genetic variant is fun for those looking for something a little different
- Reach the same size as regular guinea pigs
- Nicknamed "little house hippos" because their lack of hair makes them look like small hippopotamuses
