<b>Habitat</b>	10 Gal or Larger Arboreal Terrarium with Locking Lid Juveniles 1 - 5 Gal Arboreal Terrarium with Locking Lid
<b>Temp Range</b>	75° - 82°F, Day 68° - 75°F, Night
<b>Substrate</b>	Coconut Fiber, Reptile Bark, or Moss Substrate
<b>Hides</b>	Artificial Rock/Wood Hide, Branches
<b>Lighting</b>	Fluorescent or Low Wattage Heat Lamp
<b>Diet</b>	Insects and Crested Gecko Diet
<b>Water Source</b>	Small Water Dish
<b>Humidity</b>	Above 50%
<b>Handling</b>	Handle with Care
<b>Max Size</b>	7" - 9"
<b>Life Span</b>	10 - 15 years
<b>Habitat Mates</b>	Not Recommended

## HELPFUL TIPS

- + Are nocturnal and spend most of the day sleeping
- + Are great jumpers and love to climb
- + Can tolerate limited gentle handling
- + Tail will not regenerate if broken or detaches



## FUN FACTS

- Nicknamed the Eyelash Gecko due to the ridges that run along the top of their eyes
- Prehensile tail allows them to grab onto vines and branches
- Come in many different colors and patterns; no two are alike
- Do not have eyelids and moisten their eyes by licking them
