Temp Range	75° - 85°F, Cool Side 90° - 95°F, Basking 65° - 75°F, Night
Substrate	Coconut Fiber
Hides	Rock/Wood Hides, Branches, Plants
Lighting	UVA/UVB
Diet	Insects
Water Source	Shallow Water Bowl
Humidity	50 - 70%; Mist Daily
Handling	Handle With Care; Do Not Grab Tail
Max Size	7" - 9"
Life Span	Up to 25 Years
Habitat Mates	Not Recommended
