Habitat	10 Gallon Terrarium with Locking Screen Lid
Temp Range	75° - 85°F, Day 65° - 75°F, Night
Substrate	Sphagum Moss, Coconut Fiber
Hides	Hollow Logs, Reptile Vines
Lighting	UVA/UVB
Humidity	70% - 90%
Diet	Crickets & Other Insects, 2 - 3x / Week
Water Source	Water Bowl & Misting
Handling	Not Recommended
Max Size	1.5" - 5" Long
Life Span	8 - 10 Years
Habitat Mates	Yes, Similar Size

HELPFUL TIPS

- + Offer a variety of large leaf plants to climb on
- + Limit handling and wet hands first to avoid damaging the frog's skin
- + Keep humidity in range to avoid health issues
- + Keep the habitat clean to avoid infections
