Temp Range	70° - 75°F
Substrate	Sand, Coconut Fiber, Mixture
Hides	Heavy Foliage, Vines
Lighting	Flourescent, LED
Diet	Vegetables & Fruits, Night Time Feeder
Water Source	Shallow Dish for Soaking
Humidity	70 - 80%
Handling	Handle With Caution
Max Size	6" Long
Life Span	5 - 15 years
Habitat Mates	Yes

HELPFUL TIPS

- + Need to have access to a shallow dish full of water at all times
- + Enrichment can be added such as wood and hides
- + To breathe properly, humidity must be maintained
- + Keeping your habitat clean will reduce chance of sickness
- + Add multiple shells to allow the crab to select a new one when molting

- Found in the Caribbean
- Will trade or steal shells from other crabs
- Tests shell with large claw
