Habitat	10 - 20 Gal Terrarium with Locking Screen Lid
Temp Range	75° - 85°F
Substrate	Aspen Shavings, Mulch-Type, Reptile Bark
Hides	Anything with at Least Two Crevices/Hiding Spaces
Lighting	Regular/UVB Optional; Provide 8 - 12 Hours of Light Daily
Diet	Frozen Rodents
Water Source	Large Bowl
Humidity	40% - 60%
Handling	Handle With Care
Max Size	3 ft - 6 ft
Life Span	10 - 15 Years
Habitat Mates	Not Recommended

- + Make Sure Snake Is No More Than Twice As Long As Enclosure
- + Deep Clean Cage at Least Once a Week
