- + Need unlimited access to Timothy hay
- + Feed specific diet
- + Can be offered dark leafy greens on occasion
- + Keep habitat clean to avoid respiratory infections
- + Need large habitat
- + Needs multiple chews in habitat to prevent overgrown teeth

- Can be litter box trained
- Thump their feet when they feel threatened
- When content they "purr" by quickly clicking their teeth
- When happy they jump and often shake their heads
