Habitat	10 Gal or Larger Terrarium with Locking Lid
Temp Range	85°F, Basking 75°F, Cool Side
Substrate	Coconut Fiber
Hides	Artificial Rock, Wood Branches
Diet	Crickets and Other Insects
Water Source	Shallow Water Dish
Humidity	65% - 80%
Handling	Not Recommended
Max Size	2.5" - 4.5"
Life Span	Females up to 18 years Males 2 - 3 years
Habitat Mates	Not Recommended

HELPFUL TIPS

- + Prone to substantial injury if dropped
- + Recommended as an observation animal
- + While docile in demeanor, will display darting speeds when startled
- + Substrate should be 2" - 3" deep, which allows them to burrow
- + Deep clean and disinfect habitat at least once a week



FUN FACTS

- Also known as the Costa Rican Zebra Tarantula
- Found in the grasslands and forests of Costa Rica
- Females are typically dark brown with lighter brown bordering while males are dark with purple around their eyes
