HELPFUL TIPS

- + Must Be Able to Shelter from Heat After Basking
- + Do Not Allow Substrate or Enclosure to Become Damp
- + Feeding Crickets/Insects Can Compromise Health
- Must Use Purified and Dechlorinated Water

PIN FACTS

- Can Change Color—Become Darker to Absorb More Sunlight, Turn Lighter If Too Hot
- Hibernate 2-5 Months in Winter
- Name Derived from Ancient Greek "Tail" + "Whip"
