HELPFUL TIPS

- + **Must Be Able to Shelter from Heat After Basking**
- + **Do Not Allow Substrate or Enclosure to Become Damp**
- + **Feeding Crickets/Insects Can Compromise Health**
- + **Must Use Purified and Dechlorinated Water**



FUN FACTS

- **Can Change Color—Become Darker to Absorb More Sunlight, Turn Lighter If Too Hot**
- **Hibernate 2-5 Months in Winter**
- **Name Derived from Ancient Greek "Tail" + "Whip"**
