



# **DTF HEATPRESS SETTINGS**

# **GENERAL SETTINGS**

(DTFPRO Cold Peel film and DTFPRO inks)

PRESSURE: 60LB of pressure

**POLY:** 275/10seconds **TRI:** 275/10seconds **50/50:** 300/12seconds

COTTON: 325/15seconds

For a matte look for the transfer, press a second time with Kraft Paper for 10 Seconds.

#### ADDITIONAL SUGGESTIONS

#### **COTTONS** and **BLENDS**

300-315/325 F for 10-12s Second press 5-10s Medium pressure is best. Hoodies may require 325 and up, medium press 10-12

## **POLYESTERS:**

265-275/285 F for 8-1Os Med-light pressure, (if they are thinner), otherwise, it creates a box or scorches transfer.

Polyester settings may vary a lot, but best to use lower temp and pressure generally

#### **FINISHING**

Matte finish: Cover sheet: Kraft/parchment cover sheet, rougher

texture. Shiny/gloss finish: Teflon cover sheet

Specific silicone pads with texture can be used to prevent gloss look, gives print a nice textured feel.

Thicker fabrics require more heat, generally.

Hats (poly) may require 245-250 for 5-8 s, Umbrellas, EZ-ups, stadium chairs will require testing and trial and error.

Do a 24hr test (fine tuning) for a day to see if the ink migrates (clothing dye reacts with the DTF ink)

### **GARMENT TYPES**

DTF works with almost all Fabrics and garment types:

Combed Cotton, Ring Spun Cotton, Organic Cotton, Polyesters, Blended Fabrics, Poly-Cottons, Tri-Blends, Polyester-Spandex, Leather, Vinyl, Denim, Canvas and much more.
