INTRODUCING LEVI



After many months of looking for a job, Levi came to Opportunity Village's Pathway to Work Program at the suggestion of his case manager at Desert Regional Center.

After being out of work for many months, Levi found that he needed to relearn the skills he once proudly possessed. He was determined not only to relearn the skills he had lost, but also to learn everything possible to make himself a great job candidate. With the help of his OV Job Coordinator, who drew up task lists and pictures for him to study at home, Levi excelled.

The Opportunity Village Job Developer and Levi began to search for possible job openings and he applied at popular local concert venue Brooklyn Bowl. Soon, he was called for an interview. He practiced his interview skills with focused determination and aced the interview! Levi began his new job at Brooklyn Bowl in November 2017 and continues on his path to excellence. He still studies new job responsibilities at home in order to continue to excel.

Levi is a determined and motivated man, enjoying the freedom he has through his social and financial independence. Even more important, he is so proud to be an essential part of the Brooklyn Bowl team.


THANK YOU OV DONORS
