## Assembly Instructions For The Poly Classic Rocker

Tools Needed For Assembly
7/16" Wrench
7/16" Socket
Screwgun
\#2 Square Drive Bit

$1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 3-1 / 2^{\text {" }}$ Carriage Bolts (4)
$1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 2-3 / 4^{n}$ Camriage Bolts (2)
$1 / 4^{\pi} \times 2^{-\pi}$ Carriage Bolts (4)
$1 / 4^{n}$ Flange Nuts (10)
2-1/2 $2^{\prime \prime}$ Screws (4)

Step 1 Place the seat assembly on edge with the front slat facing down. Put the arm \& leg assemblies on each side. (The curved side on the arm belongs on the outside). Align the holes in the legs with the holes in the side of the seat assembly. Insert the 3-1/2" bolts through the legs, in through the seat assembly, \& put flange nuts on the inside. Semi-figiten only, do not fully tighten umilithe backis attached.

Step 2 Set the chair upright and place the back assembly between the arms. Align the holes in the back of the arms with the holes in the side of the back assembly. Fasten with the two $2-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ bolts and two flange nuts. Now attach the bottom of the back assembly to the back of the seat with the four $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ screws in the predrilled holes. There are no predrilled holes needed in the back of the seat as screws ane self drilling:

Step 3 Attach the rockers to the bottom of the legs with four 2" bolts. Put flange nuts on the inside and tighten all nuts with the wrench or socket.
