At The Bike Project, we take second-hand bikes, fix them up, and donate them to refugees and asylum seekers. Having fled persecution and atrocity in their country of origin, most refugees arrive in the UK with absolutely nothing. Public transport is expensive and a bike helps our beneficiaries access food banks, legal advice, healthcare and education so that they can begin to integrate into British society.

Enough for one of the comprehensive cycling safety kits that we give to all our beneficiaries, including helmet, high-vis, lights and lock.

Means we can donate a kid's bike to a young refugee for them to enjoy on family rides, plus all the gear that they need to stay safe.
