Dig down and you'll find layer upon layer of nuanced peaty goodness.

In this latest release in the Son of a Peat trilogy, the flavor DNA of Son of a Peat expands and evolves, taking its distinctive taste to new heights. The essence of Scotland's Islay, Islands, Highland, and Speyside regions are trickled down the cooling pipes to be reborn as a complex peated maelstrom. This is another commanding whisky set to spark the love for peat in the kilns of your heart.

Grisa Soba, master blender of Son of a Peat, said: "With Son of a Peat The Redeemer we weren't looking to create a crowd-pleaser. This was blended for those that can handle a bit of a kick in their glass, those in need of a little something different to awaken the senses and break up the monotony of the mundane and those who aren't afraid to embrace explosive peaty flavor and are craving excitement. Smoothness, whatever that means, is overrated in whisky: those that really love peated Scotch know that the real fun starts beyond the pain threshold with something that demands you surrender your palate to flavor. And if you haven't yet embraced the power of peat in your glass, trust me, you should. It will redeem you."
