STEP 1

Slide H-bar in Image 2 onto the two prods on the U-shaped base in Image 1.

STEP 2

Push in buttons to slide H bar in Image 2 onto the U-shaped base in Image 1. Move it into place until button comes out of the leg support as in Image 4.

Cup bath tub in Image 6 to back of capsule in Image 5. Adjust so that the holes in the bath tub are aligned with the holes shown in Image 5.

STEP 5

Use allen key provided to screw two screws on either side of the capsule.

STEP 6

Screw cap to bottom of bath tub. Resulting in Image 7.


- (A) Waist Strap buckle prong and holder

A five point harness is provided to restrain your child.

To secure your child in the harness please follow the steps below carefully. Make sure the connector (B) is connected with the Buckle prongs holder on the waist straps (A)

Push buckle (A) into the buckle housing (C) until the buckle prongs snap into position. Carefully adjust the harness by pulling the slider (D) until the desired fit is achieved in the lap and shoulder straps. Always adjust the harness when changing the seating position of the child.

To remove the child, release the buckle by squeezing the top and bottom prongs, remove the shoulder straps and lift the child out of the highchair.



WHEN NOT IN USE DISCONNECT SHOULDER STRAPS FROM THE WAIST STRAP AND/OR BUCKLE

ALWAYS use the same height slots for both sides of the shoulder straps. Use the IMAGE 9 lower shoulder position for newborns.

After using the chair you may remove the straps and give the five point harness a clean. To do this feed strap tab back through opening.

When replacing the five point harness push strap tab together and push through opening on its side. Inspect strap tabs and ensure tabs are flat against back seat, as in Image 9. Pull straps to ensure that they are secure.





USING THE SEAT

To adjust recline position first ensure child is not in seat.

- 1. Turn adjustment spindle anticlockwise, as in Image 11.
- 2. Push seat upwards or downwards according to desired position. Seat has 2 positions.
- 3. To stabilize position turn adjustment spindle clockwise, as in Image 12. Push down on seat firmly but gently in order to ensure the seat is secure.

To adjust height position first ensure child is not in seat.

- 1. Push the buttons located on both sides of the H-bar, as seen in Image 13, and move seat upwards or downwards according to the desired height. The seat has 3 height adjustments.
- 2. To ensure seat is secure and stable you should hear and see the button pop out of the hole. Pull down on it slightly to ensure the chair is firm.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

The shower seat with attached straps and belts may be wiped clean using a mild cleaning solution and a damp cloth. Do not use bleach. Do not use harsh or abrasive cleaners. Rinse clean with water to remove residue.

From time to time check your high chair for loose screws, worn parts, torn material or stitching. Replace or repair the parts as needed. Excessive exposure to the sun or heat could cause fading, yellowing or warping of parts.

CLEANING THE CHASSIS: periodically clean all plastic parts with a damp cloth. Do not use solvent or similar cleaning products; keep all metal parts dry to prevent rusting; keep moving parts clean (adjustment mechanisms, locking mechanisms, wheels, ...) and free of dust and sand and, if necessary, lubricate with light machine oil all metallic moving parts. Check all nuts and bolts for tightness and tighten when required. Check all coverings for bolts and sharp edges and replace when required. Replace when required in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions. DO NOT place any of the parts into a dishwasher or washing machine to clean them.

Clean restraint system straps and buckles using a soft cloth with warm water and mild soap. Clean seat with a soft cloth using warm water and mild soap. Disinfectant wipes can also be used. To clean the straps - washed the strap in warm soapy water ,rinse and dry in the sun. If storing away store in airtight bag to avoid mould build up.
