

Unlike conventional acetate, Plantix is a type of Bio-Acetate, produced from more naturally renewable materials. The production process uses plant-based polymers to create this magical material, which is then coloured with plant-based dyes.

Natural plasticisers


Plantix uses natural plasticisers giving these frames a lower carbon footprint than traditional acetate and plastic. They're durable, flexible and fully repairable.





Our alloy frames are both beautiful and endlessly recyclable. We've restyled some of the most iconic shapes and given them the Bird treatment, thoughtfully designed with exceptional features to be discovered, including a cleverly hidden split-pin to open the frames, subtle etchings and a full alloy side that is easy to adjust.

Our innovative bioplastic is an eco-friendly version of plastic, it's made without crude oil, uses plant based dyes and is certified biodegradable. By using a mix of bioplastics and recycled materials, we ensure these frames have an ultra low carbon impact of just 113 grams of CO2 per frame (which is less impact than using your phone for 1 hour).

The real magic bean

Birdies are made from processed castor beans, a new (and old) natural polymer that is lighter than aluminium and strong enough to be used in vehicles.

These frames are virtually indestructible. Designed to withstand rough treatment, they're bendable, throwable, and come with impact and shatter-resistant lenses. The low-density material is 10 times stronger than the plastics in car bumpers, and 13 times stronger than common bioplastics. The perfect material for inquisitive minds.



Environmentally friendly materials

We use water based acrylic dies in our colouring of woods and our eco-cork cases have been certified to conform to ROHS directive and ISO 17226. Our cleaning cloths are made from recycled PET bottles.



Water soluble packaging

Our mailer bags are made from harmless water-soluble EcoWrap, so there's no plastic to be found anywhere.






Responsible sourcing

We've fully mapped our supply chain which is publicly available for people to see. All material is carefully selected, verified, and sustainably sourced.

Our packaging is both recyclable and biodegradable, and through mapping our greenhouse gas emissions, we know the carbon footprint of every frame, from raw material to end of life.



Research and development

Working with Plymouth University we have mapped out our carbon footprint at a molecular level.



Nature inspired innovation

We use plant based materials in all our frames, taking inspiration from nature for design, colours, shapes and innovative uses.

It's no secret that we thrive on nature here at Bird. In fact, looking after our environment is even written into our business code of conduct. Our Bird Forest will see us plant over 10,000 trees in the next two years, alongside re-wilding and habitat cultivation across a number of sites.

If that's not enough, every pair of Birds gives back through our Share Your Sun partnership with SolarAid. Helping to distribute solar light to families in Zambia and Malawi, replacing the use of fossil fuel burning lamps.

Certified B Corporations are rigorously verified to meet the highest standards of social and environmental impact, and balance purpose with profit. They are third-party verified and legally required to consider the impact of their decisions on their workers, customers, suppliers, community, and the environment.

Some of the factors contributing to our growing success include planting our very own Bird forest in Devon as part of our carbon reduction drive, alongside developing a new line of products made from waste collected in Devon, and building out our transparent supply chain.
