# **Important Safety Precautions**

- 1. Please read all the instructions carefully before using this product.
- 2. BE SURE TO unplug the power cord when cleaning LCD. Never clean it with liquid detergent or spraying detergent, but wipe it with wet soft cloth. If it is still not clean, please use special detergent for LCD.
- 3. DO NOT use accessories not authorized by the manufacturer, other wise they may incur danger.
- 4. When disconnecting the power cord of display or power adapter, always remember to hold the plug instead of puling the wire to unplug the power cord.
- 5. Keep the display away from water sources such as bath tub, washbasin, sink or washing machine. DO NOT place the display on wet floor or near a swimming pool, or press LCD surface with fingers or hard objects.
- 6. The grooves and openings on the back and bottom of the shell are for ventilation purpose and also for guaranteeing the reliability of the elements and preventing them from overheating; in order to prevent the vents from blocking; DO NOT place the display on bed, sofa, carpet or other similar surfaces; DO NOT place the display near to or on heat radiator or heater; DO NOT put the display into embedded device, unless it is provided with adequate ventilating equipment.
- 7. Only the type of power source indicated on the nameplate applies to this display. If you have any questions on the type of power source you use, please consult the dealer of the display or local administration of power supply.
- 8. Since there is high voltage or other risks when the shell is opened or moved, please DO NOT repair the display by yourself, but request qualified maintenance staff to carry out.
- 9. In one of the following cases, please unplug the display or the power adapter and ask qualified maintenance staff for help:
  - a. The power cord or the plug is impaired or worn.
  - b. The display falls off or the shell is damaged.
  - c. The display is obviously abnormal.
- 10. Please place the display in a cool, dry and well ventilated place.

#### 1.1 Packing list

- •When lifting or moving the monitor, do not touch the monitor screen. The force applied to the monitor screen may cause damage to it.


#### 2. Installation and Connection

### 2.1 Display installation

Installation instructions


- This Monitor should be installed adjacent to an easily accessible AC power socket.
- For the sake of safety, we suggest that a suitable UL certified wall-mounted bracket or base be used.
- In order to prevent injury, this Monitor shall be placed on a stable and level surface or fixed on a firm wall.
- For wall-mounting, please ask a professional to do so. Improper installation may cause instability of this monitor.
- DO NOT place this monitor in places with mechanical vibration.
- DO NOT place this monitor in places where insects, rodents, or other pests are accessible.

- DO NOT install this monitor directly opposite to air-conditioner, otherwise its inner panel may be dewed and cause failure.
- DO NOT place this monitor in places with strong electromagnetic fields, otherwise it may be interfered by the electromagnetic wave and get damaged.




#### 2.2 Instruction of Base Installation

- 1. Base installation steps:
- 1) Insert the base into the support and lock 3 M4\*16 screws, as shown in Figure 1.
- ② Insert the base into the hole position of the rear shell at an angle in the direction of the arrow, as shown in Figure 2.
- ③ Rotate the entire base clockwise down and load, as shown in Figures 2 and 3.



- 2. Base removal steps:
- ① Push the slider near the base VESA cover up, as shown in Figure 1.
- ② Rotate the entire base upwards counterclockwise, as shown in Figure 1.
- ③ Take out the base obliquely in the direction of the arrow, as shown in Figure 2.
- ④ Unscrew the 3 M4\*16 screws on the base and pull out the base in the direction of the arrow, as shown in Figure 3.

#### **Installation Tips**

- If you need to remove the base, first place the monitor face down in the original packaging protection material to avoid screen damage.
- For a base with quick disassembly and assembly functions, press the release button to remove the base in the reverse operation.

# 2.3 Signal line connection

Connect the signal line to output interfaces signal of HDMI/DP/USB-C signals of PC, and the connect the other end of the signal line to the corresponding signal input port of the display.

# 2.4 Audio output

This monitor supports earphone audio output.

# 3. Operation of Display

### 3.1 Safety protection

When the video signals of PC exceeds the frequency range of the display, the horizontal and field synchronizing signals will be shut down to protect the display. Then, you have to set the PC output frequency to an acceptable range so as to make the display work normally.

# **5. Basic Troubleshooting**

Phenomenon	Troubleshooting
1. Light out/power indicator light is off	Check whether the display and the socket are well connected to power, and whether the display is in the shutdown mode.
2. Image over dark	Enter the menu "Brightness and Contrast" to adjust the brightness and contrast of the display.
3. Display over heat	Leave at least 5cm of distance for ventilation around the display and do not place articles on the display.
4. Dark/ light spots when powering on	This is a normal phenomenon. It is due to the backlight illuminates unevenly at the initial phase of powering on caused by temperature difference. The backlight can illuminates normally after 20 minutes, and then the dark/light spots will be corrected.
5. Image distortion, blinking, shaking	Check computer setting, select the correct resolution and re-adjust the refresh frequency.
6. Power off noise	It is a normal phenomenon caused by display discharging in the process of powering off.
